We've had a great response to our appeal for assistance with identifying the tens of thousands of people and places captured by Tom Lennon's camera in the 1950s and 1960s. But there are still plenty of photographs to be recognised and named.

So we still need everyone's help. Think of the photographs you and your family have taken over the years and how many of those are currently sitting in albums or in boxes yet unlabelled.

The day will come when it is no longer possible to identify the people and places and so the images will lose their meaning. We have the same situation here, except there are roughly 80,000 unidentified images in our collection.
