

Getting to and from CSU in Orange



The CSU Orange Campus is approximately 4.7 kilometres from the Orange central business district (CBD). The walking route from the CBD (corner of Mitchell Highway & Lords Place) to CSU takes you along Lords Place, Dalton Street, William Street onto Leeds Parade. Walking time from the CBD to CSU is approximately 55 minutes and is marked on the map in this TAG.



Orange BUSLINES operate the bus services in Orange. There is one route that services CSU Orange Campus. The route number is:

Route 538 CSU (via Bletchington & North Orange).

Route 538 services run in a loop from the CBD to CSU main entrance and returns back to the CBD.

CSU students can travel at concession fares upon the presentation to the driver of an appropriate photo ID from CSU. These services do not operate on Sunday or Public Holidays.

As the service ends in either the CBD, you will need to coordinate with other bus services or modes of active transport to reach your destination. Further bus information, timetables and maps can be located at www.orangebuslines.com.au.

CSU Orange Campus is easily accessed by bicycle. The direct cycle route from Orange CBD to CSU is via Lords Place, Dalton Street, William Street onto Leeds Parade. The distance is approximately 4.6 kilometres with an average trip time of 15 minutes. The route is marked on the map in this TAG.

Bike parking is located at buildings **1001** (Administration), between **1000** (gym / bar) and **1005** (library), **1003** (Pharmacy), alongside the paths between **1005** (Library) and **1014** (Community Health) and alongside the path between **Carpark 2** and building **1006** (Dentistry). Public shower and change facilities are available in buildings **1000** (bar / bistro / gym), **1013** and **1014**.

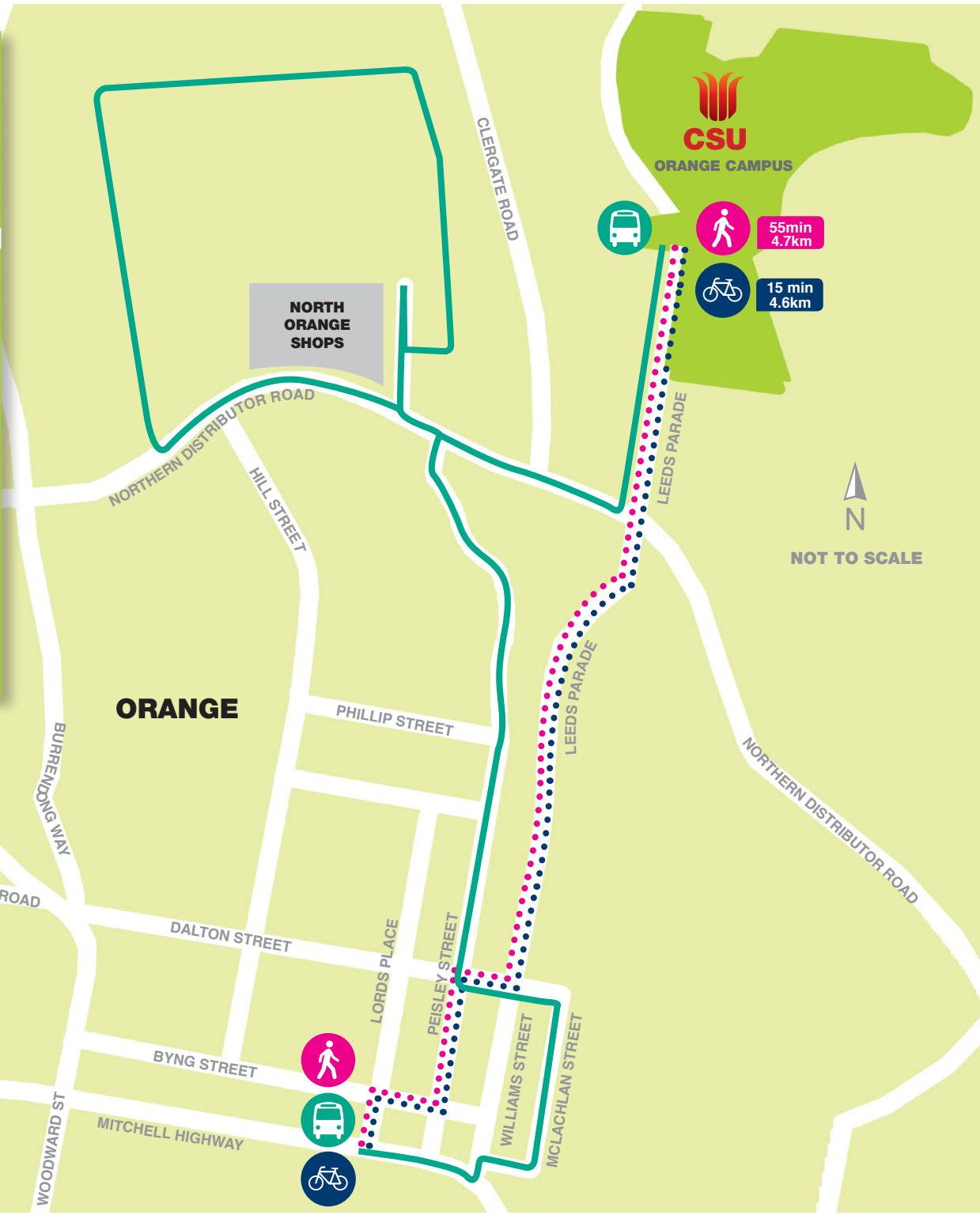
