Indicative program outline: This itinerary is subject to change and should be used as a guide only.

Day	Date	Activity
0	Saturday, 19 August 2023	Participants meet in Darwin to prepare for the program and next day's flight.
1	Sunday, 20 August 2023	Group arrives in Dili and transfer to accommodation. Evening welcome dinner and program introduction
2	Monday, 21 August 2023	am: The program will commence with a walking tour of the city pm: After lunch you will engage in language and cultural lessons, with a group dinner in the evening.
3	Tuesday, 22 August 2023	am: This morning you'll visit the <u>National University of East Timor</u> (NUET) to meet with staff and students of the university pm: A visit to the <u>Australian Consortium for International</u> <u>Agricultural Research</u> (ACIAR) is scheduled as well as a group dinner to debrief about the day's activities
4	Wednesday, 23 August 2023	am: You'll return to NUET to continue discussions with your peers pm: This afternoon's site visit is to Carbon Offset Timor to learn how the organisation works with communities to combat the impacts of climate change. A group dinner will conclude the day
5	Thursday, 24 August 2023	am: The group will visit the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries pm: You have the afternoon free to work on your program research project before regrouping for a Timorese cooking class and dinner
6	Friday, 25 August 2023	am: Your day will start with a visit to Timor-Leste's World Vision office pm: You'll again have the afternoon free for your research project before regrouping for dinner and a debrief
7	Saturday, 26 August 2023	all day: You'll travel to the rural town of Gleno to meet with local producers to learn about farming and production techniques. You'll return to Dili in the afternoon to explore Dili and sample it's local eateries.
8	Sunday, 27 August 2023	all day: Another full day tour will take you to the village of Maubisse to meet locals and enjoy lunch. You'll return to Dili in the afternoon to continue your exploration of Dili
9	Monday, 28 August 2023	all day: Today you'll travel to Maliana for an overnight visit. You'll meet staff involved in the management of project sites and end the day dining together.

10	Tuesday, 29 August 2023	am: On your way back to Dili you'll call in to Balibo to visit another project site pm: The evening is your own for exploring or relaxing.
11	Wednesday, 30 August 2023	all day: Today you'll move on to Baucau where you'll visit more project sites and spend the night
12	Thursday, 31 August 2023	all day: You'll be out and about today travelling from Baucau to Lospalos to visit more project sites before dinner and debriefs - staying the night in Lospalos
13	Friday, 1 September 2023	am: You will say goodbye to your Lospalos hosts and travel back to Dili pm: the day will end with a debrief session, project reflections and a farewell dinner
14	Saturday, 2 September 2023	Travel day - you'll check-out of your accommodation and transfer to the airport to head back to Darwin.
15	Sunday, 3 September 2023	Depart Darwin for home
