



AN EXPLORATION OF CONCUSSION EXPERIENCE AMONG FEMALE PARTICIPANTS IN AMATEUR CONTACT AND COLLISION SPORTS: A QUALITATIVE STUDY

Women's participation in contact sport is growing — but concussion research hasn't kept up. Have you experienced a concussion due to participation in sport? If so, this study invites you to share your concussion experiences to help us better understand female athlete health and shape safer guidelines for women's sport.

What does the study involve?

Short-online interview to discuss your experiences. Your responses will have any identifying information removed from your interview data prior to publication.

Who can participate?

Any female athlete aged 18 years or older that sustained concussion due to participation in Rugby Union, Rugby League, AFL and/or Soccer

Why participate?

Female athletes are starkly under-represented in the concussion literature! Participation in this study will allow us to improve our understanding of amateur female athlete concussion, hopefully allowing us to prioritise safety in women's contact and collision sports.
