

2021 National Careers Week Competition Terms and Conditions (Game of Chance)

By entering the "2021 National Careers Week" (**Competition**) you accept the following terms and conditions.

Promoter

Competition Period

2. The Competition will commence on 17 May 2021 at 12.01am AEST and close 21 May 2021 at 11.59pm AEST (**Competition Period**). Any entry submitted outside the Competition Period will be invalid.

Eligibility

3. Subject to clause 5, entry in the Competition is open to all residents of Australia (**Entrant**).
4. Entrants who are under 18 years acknowledge and agree that they have the consent of their parent or guardian to enter the Competition.
5. Current employees of Charles Sturt and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter the Competition.

How to enter

6. Entry into the Competition is free. To enter, register and attend a Careers and Skills Hub workshop during National Careers Week. Each Entrant represents and warrants that all details provided with their entry card are true and correct.
7. There is a limit of 1 entry per Entrant.

Prize
