CHARLES STURT DENTAL CLINICS

Regular oral health check-ups and preventive dental cleaning is a very important part of maintaining your general health. Charles Sturt Dental Clinics include learning facilities that support students training to be Oral Health Therapists through the Bachelor of Oral Health program.

Appointments are available to see Oral Health Therapy students at the Dental and Oral Health Student Clinics in Albury and Wagga. CSCS staff are eligible to receive free checkups and cleans with our Oral Health Therapy students. Subsequent treatment may incur additional fees, if required.

Oral health therapists are experts in preventing dental decay and gum disease. Under the direct supervision of registered dental practitioners, oral health therapy students provide comprehensive check-ups and cleans for patients of any age. Children and young people (up to 26 years) can be seen for additional procedures such as simple fillings and extractions of baby teeth. Students will refer any complex dental treatment to other dental team members such as dentists and specialists for ongoing dental care.

If you don't have a regular dentist or oral health therapist, please consider visiting the student dental clinics in Albury or Wagga.

CSCS External business continues to grow with Graham and his team successfully obtaining additional works for our current clients as well as a new client in Marathon Health in Albury.


