

Recycle your toner cartridges

It's easy to recycle your used toner cartridges through the program facilitated by Ricoh. This system has been set up to collect all brands of toner cartridges in a central location.

Toner collections on campus

The central point of collection will be within stores or with a representative at each campus, who will facilitate collection and pick up of used toner cartridges for recycling with Ricoh. This process aims to improve recycling of toner cartridges at each campus with one collection point for external couriers.



It's been estimated that more than 80% (approx. 18 million) of Australian's used cartidges go to landfill each year.

What happens to the cartridges?

Ricoh believes that the biggest action we can take to reduce our environmental impact is to reduce our level of wastage and resources, prolong the life of our products through reuse, or recycle end of life material into a feed stream for new products.

By participating in Ricoh's recycling program, Charles Sturt University can be assured that used toner cartridges are broken down into raw materials, which in turn are purchased by companies for downstream processes.

Raw materials can then be used to produce products such as outdoor furniture, carpets, and even recycle bins. Ricoh will accept used consumables from any manufacturer's facsimile machine, printer or photocopier from Ricoh customers.
