General Exemption

About this form

- A General Exemption allows people without a radiation user licence (eg students) to do radiation work under the supervision of a licenced person.
- A General Exemption can only be issued by a person with a **General Approval to Exempt from Licensing** (**GE1**) condition on their radiation user licence.
 - If the general exemption issuer is <u>not</u> in a position to directly supervise, or they <u>do not</u> have a licence
- condition that matches the work being performed (eg IA14 for medical diagnostic radiography), they must ensure that the person is appropriately supervised by another licensee who is on-site and has licence condition that match the work being performed.
