Subject: Update - Brightspace Roles are Changing

Dear Colleagues,

We're excited to share some upcoming changes to roles and permissions in Brightspace. One of the amazing things about Brightspace, is it allows for users to have precisely tailored roles in different parts of the system. These updates are helping us build a more adaptive, inclusive and seamless LMS.

From **30 January 2024**, we will be introducing the following newly created roles and permissions. These have been developed through extensive consultation with stakeholders.

Role	Purpose
Subject Convenor	Oversee master or session site; edit, manage content, assessment, and add additional staff as required
Teaching Staff (Additional)	Edit content in the site at the discretion of the Subject Convenor (can be added via ACSE)
Marker	View content as a member of teaching staff, participate in discussions, and mark student submissions
Guest Access	View content
Faculty access	Broad role designed for faculty leadership and administration
School access	Broad role designed for school leadership and administration
Subject Co-ordinator	Edit session site and manage assessment

We're keen to get your feedback on how we can refine these roles via your Head of School or Area Representative for our Core Reference Group.
