

- Be introduced to subject level learner data available to instructors within the subject site



'Preparation'

Master site

Master subject site is the **source of truth for your subject** content in the LMS

- Persistent site to curate content
- Limited access Subject Convener+, no students
- · All content is visible
- · All assessments for all cohorts
- No gradebook
- · No engagement reporting

'Delivery' **Subject sites** Subject sites are the working copies of a subject for use in a single session Content specific to student cohort and session e.g., 2024 60 WD Broader access - Teaching academic staff, tutors, students Only content offering content visible Only relevant assessments visible Gradebook Engagement reporting







Assumptions

Session Subject site checklist:

- Learning Materials (Content) are fit for purpose → provisioned from the
 Master site
- Assessment 'shells' are available, but may not have been 'deployed' yet
- Students have been enrolled into the subject site (Course Admin → Classlist), sections (cohorts) will be in place
- Discussion forum structure may have been established if so, no prior student posts
- That you have been added to the subject site (or have access to a sandbox)



Subject Home Page

Behaves in the following ways:

- 'Nav' contains more options specific to the subject
- 'My Topics' widget (incl. progress indicator)
- Announcements widget
- Calendar widget (mini-cal + events)
- Activity Feed widget
- Subject Welcome widget




Subject 'Welcome' (content area & widget)


As the first content module / folder in every subject in Brightspace, the Welcome folder will contain content migrated from your old i2 landing page (or separate 'Home' entry). This content will pop up automatically for first time users accessing the subject, via the subject home page 'Welcome Widget'.


The Welcome provides an opportunity for you to:

- provide an introduction to the subject
- establish Teacher Presence, build community within the cohort and add friendly rapport within the learning materials
- provide an orientation to the subject unpacking 'expectations' around both subject delivery (teacher) and engagement (students)
- identify the people involved in delivering the subject, contact information, communication protocols etc.

Note. The 'Welcome' folder Is NOT a replacement for detail captured in: Subject Outline, Contacts widget*, Announcements, Discussions etc.








Announcements (tool vs widget)

The Announcement Tool behaves in the following ways:

- Messages will appear in the student notifications area (minibar), announcement widgets, under announcements
- Brightspace editor (WYSIWYG) → third party content can be embedded*
- File Attachments
- Availability (start / end dates)
- Release conditions
- Draft vs Publish




Subject Calendar Tool

Assignments <u>Checklists</u> Discussions Events Grades Materials Modules Quizzes Surveys

Behaves in the following ways:


- Accessible via Brightspace Home, Subject Home (widget), Course Admin (tool)
- Will capture any 'activity' with a due date attached to it (assessable or otherwise)
- Toggle-able views (agenda / day-week-month / list)
- Filterable views via the calendar menu
- Contains a 'mini calendar' (window)
- 'Task' pane → create & track personal tasks (incl due dates + notes)
- Individual Calendar subscription (for outlook integration)



Subject Activity Feed


Behaves in the following manner:

- Persistent individual posts to the subject home page message pinning possible
- Toggle-able learner comments on posts
- 'Insert stuff' option available, however restricted 'real estate' on the home page
- Subject Content / local file attachments
- Content 'post to homepage' option
- Consider 'double handling' vs Announcements




Brightspace Pulse (mobile app)

- Available on both Android and IOS devices
- Review subject content
- Review subject grades and feedback (students)
- Contribute to subject activity (e.g. discussions)
- Push notifications (toggle)
- Brightspace Calendar view upcoming activities









Minibar: Notifications

Subject Level Activity:

- Connection to 'Pulse' application
- Activity summary (toggle / adjust)
- Instant notifications (SMS* / email)
- Include / exclude 'courses' (subjects)
- Subject activity 'digest' feature







Managing Discussions

Forums \rightarrow Topics \rightarrow Threads \rightarrow Replies

- Can be 'restricted' (cohorts / groups)
- Considerations around pre-established structure (Master)
- 'Pin' thread feature
- Brightspace editor available (descriptions / posts)*
- Changeable views (standard, grid etc.)
