**The Charles Sturt Medal is awarded annually to one coursework student to recognise both academic achievement and public service consistent with the University's motto 'for the public good'.**

### Eligibility

To be eligible to nominate you must:

- have graduated or be eligible to graduate from an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework course in the relevant calendar year;
- have received or be eligible to receive an Undergraduate, Postgraduate, or Bachelor (Honours) University medal in the relevant calendar year; and
- have demonstrated a significant commitment to the public good.
