SPECIAL CONSIDERATION FOR ADMISSION

INFORMATION

Charles Sturt University is committed to providing Elite / Pre-Elite Athletes, Elite Sports Personnel and Elite Performers equal access to fully participate and succeed at University. Charles Sturt recognises that the training, performing or competitive commitments of Elite / Pre-Elite Athletes, Elite Sports Personnel and Elite Performers may have significantly affected their preparation for application to University. These prospective students may therefore be eligible to apply for the Elite Athlete / Performer Program Special Consideration for Admission (SCA).

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for an Elite / Pre-Elite Athlete, Elite Sports Personnel or Elite Performer SCA an applicant must:

- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, a permanent resident or the holder of a permanent humanitarian visa; and
- be classified as an elite athlete, elite sports personnel, emerging athlete or elite performer based on the criteria set out on page 3 and in the [CSU Elite Athlete Policy](#); and
- have had their *education* in preparation for university entrance affected by their training, competing or performing commitments in the final year/s of schooling or immediate year/s prior to university application.

How does the scheme work?

Elite Athlete and Performer SCA Applications are assessed by the Charles Sturt University Admissions Office, and where required, in consultation with the relevant Course Director. Applications will be considered for an offer based on Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking (ATAR)/grades and the documentation provided with this application. Elite Athlete and Performer SCA applicants will be advised of an offer into the course of their choice through the University Admissions office (if direct application) and/or the Universities Admissions Centre through which they have applied.

Documentation

The supporting documents that are required with this submission are:

1. Letter from your school or education institution (on letterhead) detailing your absences from study for competition, training or performing purposes;
2. Supporting documentation (on letterhead) from your coach, manager or sporting organisation confirming the level of competition and the required training schedule; and
3. Statement of most recent academic results.

Applications with incorrect or no supporting documentation will be deemed ineligible.

Elite Athlete: means a person participating at the highest level of their sport or activity. The University will grant Elite Athlete status to athletes who are national representatives selected to participate in international sporting (or cultural) events and are identified and recognised by a national supporting body or association. Other representation will be considered on an individual basis.

Pre-Elite Athlete: are athletes that have been recognised for their potential to attain high honours in their selected sport through recognition by a regional academy or NSO and its associated pathway for their chosen sport.

Elite Sports Personnel: are support people involved at the highest level of their sport or sports related activity. This includes referees, coaches, officials and support staff with the same travel and training commitments as Elite Athletes. The University will grant Elite Sports Personnel status to those involved at the national representative level and those who are identified as being associated with a national supporting body or association. Other representation will be considered on an individual basis.

Elite Performer – are people in the Performing Arts who have participated regularly in significant national or international performances, productions, competitions or events.
