Cumulative plant species list for St Mark's Grassland, Barton, ACT.

Overview: The Charles Sturt University campus at Barton, Canberra borders St Mark's Native Grassland. The site contains two hectares of Natural Temperate Grassland, which is declared an endangered ecological community under ACT and Commonwealth legislation. Two hectares have been assessed as having very high botanical value and one hectare as having moderate botanical value. The conservation grassland is dominated by Kangaroo Grass (*Themeda triandra*) and a high diversity of native wildflowers, several of which are regionally uncommon, including orchids and a number of lilies. A population of the Button Wrinklewort (*Rutidosia leptorrhynchoides*), which is declared endangered under ACT and Commonwealth legislation (ACT Government 1998a), occurs within the grassland and is the flagship species for this campus.

Golden Sun Moth, *Synemon plana*, first sighted in 1997, although Themeda grasslands are not generally identified as typical habitat. This species is listed as endangered in ACT and critically endangered under Commonwealth legislation (ACT Government 2005).
