Yindyamarra winhanganha. This is a Wiradjuri phrase meaning ‘the wisdom of respectfully knowing how to live well in a world worth living in’. It’s at the heart of everything we stand for here at Charles Sturt University.

It ties us to the First Nations Peoples whose land we are fortunate and proud to share, and to the diverse communities across Australia that we serve. It is also the driving force behind what we teach to, share with and learn from our students.

And it embodies the mission of our university, which is to develop and spread insight and knowledge in order to create a better future – through expanding educational opportunities, delivering exemplary career-focused courses and enabling original research. Because we believe in making a difference.

Our history

Our ethos, yindyamarra winhanganha, has been part of the Charles Sturt University narrative from the very start. Our history dates back more than 125 years, to the establishment in 1895 of a vocational farm at Bathurst designed to give rural people access to skills and education.

Over subsequent decades, agricultural and teaching centres were set up in Wagga Wagga and Bathurst, disseminating knowledge so individuals could improve their prospects and better serve their communities.

Charles Sturt University officially became a university in 1989, merging the former Mitchell College of Advanced Education and the Riverina Murray Institute of Higher Education, and incorporating educational facilities at Albury Wodonga, Bathurst and Wagga Wagga.

Since then we have continued to grow, and now give students from across Australia and the world access to quality university education.

Today we have campuses in Albury Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange, Port Macquarie and Wagga Wagga. We also have study locations in Canberra, Goulburn, Parramatta and Wangaratta.

Our delivery of world-class online education is informed by more than 50 years of experience in distance learning. The majority of our degrees can now be studied online.

We have unique partnerships with a wide variety of organisations, including TAFE providers, the NSW Police Force, the Anglican Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn, the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries, Commercial Radio Australia, the Islamic Sciences & Research Academy of Australia, and universities in China and Sri Lanka.

We also have many partners around the world, enabling our students to undertake international study experiences, further expanding their horizons.

The man from whom the university takes its name – Charles Napier Sturt – was a British soldier who sailed to the colony of New South Wales in 1827 to pursue his passion for exploration.

The university mace

The Charles Sturt University mace is the symbol of the university as an independent academy of scholars constituted under legal authority.

The mace is crafted from timbers indigenous to the locations of Charles Sturt University campuses. It reflects the traditions and authority of the university, and symbolises its multiple geographies and responsibilities to the people of rural and regional Australia.



The university message stick

A gift from Dubbo City Council, this wooden message stick draws on elements of local indigenous culture to represent the entire Wiradjuri nation, whose borders encompass our campuses at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange and Wagga Wagga.




























Young and old emu feathers, which hang from the mulga wood message stick, denote students of all ages. A possum painting represents the local Wilay Wiradjuri people and red ochre lines depict the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers on which the university's Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga campuses are located.



Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms bears the arms of the university at the centre. The helm sits above the arms showing a knight's helmet crowned with three golden stars atop which sits the crest – a lion holding three keys. The mantling is dressed in green and gold at either side of the helm and arms. 'For the Public Good', Charles Sturt University's motto, is inscribed to the motto scroll at the base of the arms.

The graduation ceremony

The Academic Senate recommends students to be admitted to degrees. Those students (known as graduands) will have successfully completed a course of study and the prescribed examinations. The University Council formally admits the graduands, approving conferral of award as graduates.

The university medals

Undergraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a bachelor's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Postgraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a coursework master's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Bachelor Honours University Medal

Awarded to one Honours graduate per faculty, who has completed at least 64 points of study in the course at the university, and who has achieved Class 1 as an overall grade for the Honours course. At least one examiner must indicate that the student's thesis or dissertation is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Higher Degree by Research University Medal

Awarded to one doctoral and one master's by research graduate per faculty. At least two examiners must indicate that the graduate's thesis is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Charles Sturt Medal

Awarded to one graduate annually who has both an outstanding academic achievement (including a GPA of 6.75 or higher), and has demonstrated a significant contribution to the public good consistent with the university's motto 'for the public good'.

Tammy O'Connor admits she is one of those rare and lucky people who knew early on how she wanted to make a real and lasting impact on this world.

I studied a Bachelor of Nursing at Charles Sturt University and I knew as soon as I started that I wanted to become a midwife. To me it seemed like such an awesome career.

After graduating I worked as a registered nurse and quickly enrolled in the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery at Charles Sturt while working in the maternity unit as a student midwife. The uni gave me a great platform to learn in a safe environment, and provided a good stepping stone into my career. That's why I completed a Master of Midwifery through Charles Sturt University. It opened the door to those higher level positions, including my current role as a clinical midwifery consultant for the Western NSW Local Health District.

Tammy's 'anywhere' turned out to be parts of NSW which rarely received the health and educational support services they required. Realising women in remote areas needed access to antenatal and postnatal care, Tammy has been instrumental in implementing an outreach maternity program.

I believe it's a basic human right for women to access a midwife during their pregnancy, regardless of their location. Working and living regionally provides me with the opportunity to work within the primary healthcare model of midwifery. It's what I love!

Passionate about First Nations education, she is driven to make a difference in the lives of young Aboriginal children by giving them the best start to their educational journey. Towri encompasses health, education, community engagement and family support. Early childhood care has such great flow on effects for families. Tracie Ann Edmondson

Perception, Structure, and Practice: Three Dimensions of Digital Mediatization in Australian Professional Sport

This doctoral investigation uniquely brought together leaders and media managers from Australia's elite sporting organisations to explore the influence of digital mediatization on communication management. Alongside revealing that professional sporting organisations have had to digitally transform their communications for business success, it was concluded that traditional media approaches will be crucial to thrive in a new digital era for media managers.

Doctor of Philosophy

Kane Lucas John Callaghan

A model for using social media to inform policy and communication: cases of shark management in New South Wales, Australia

This thesis presents the development and testing of a system for using social media comments to understand citizens' attitudes, values, understandings and experiences ('lived realities'). It was designed for use by policymakers and communicators as a research alternative or complement to focus groups and surveys. The thesis explores the contested policy area of shark management in NSW to refine and exemplify the system stages – identify, collect, analyse, report.

Wendy Marlene De Luca

Preparing the ethical soldier: A grounded theory of how a shared understanding of values contributes to the development of ethical practice of Australian Army Recruits

This constructivist grounded theory provided an explanation of the process of military ethics education of soldiers in the Australian Army Recruit context. The study revealed how policy drives training, and how training impacts upon the development of soldiers' ethical behaviour. Key findings demonstrated that meaningful reforms to policy, curriculum and pedagogical practices are required to support learning that is relevant to soldiers' careers in the 21st century.

Annette Robyn Gainsford

Embedding Indigenous Knowledges in the Design of Higher Education Curriculum: An International Study in Law Education

This study developed an original model to assist universities embed Indigenous knowledges in the higher education law curriculum. The model provides key guidance on forming collaborative partnerships with Indigenous peoples and communities which is essential for the authentic inclusion of Indigenous knowledges. Although the thesis was specifically focused on legal education, the model can be applied more broadly to curriculum development efforts in higher education.

Mohammad Muqem Khan

Enacting and Safeguarding Digital Intangible Heritage with Emerging Technologies and Speculative Design

The term Digital Intangible Heritage means indigenous methodologies such as ancient pulse reading knowledge. The emerging technologies refer to as emerging virtual/augmented reality frameworks. Speculative Design is one of the manifestations of the notion of design to handle complex problems in future world scenarios. This thesis discusses the continuity of cultural knowledge through heritage embodiments with the interesting objective and subjective representations.

Arif Khan

An Exploratory Prioritisation of Key Elements in Library and Information Science Practicum Supervision: a grounded theory approach

This study explored the understandings and experiences of supervisors and students about practicum supervision in the field of library and information science (LIS) using a Constructivist Grounded Theory (CGT) method. A range of supervisory roles, styles, and competencies were derived from the findings, which resulted in developing a theory of LIS practicum supervision. Implications of this theory are directly applicable to the scholarship and practice in LIS.

Duncan Christian Martin

The Virtues and Vices of Collective Moral Agents

In everyday speech, we sometimes ascribe moral virtues and vices to collections of individuals. Such ascriptions can be described as 'collective virtue statements'. In recent literature, several authors argue that collective virtue statements can be true. This thesis argues that no such author succeeds. Instead, it offers a novel approach, on which some collectives can be bearers of moral virtues and vices, and on which some collective virtue statements can be true.

Thomas Philip

Exegesis of the World: M.M. Thomas's Secular Commentaries on Scripture

The Indian theologian M. M. Thomas wrote a series of biblical commentaries that interpreted the Christian faith in the context of pluralist society. This thesis is the first study of these works. It shows that Thomas developed a unique approach to scripture, using insights from Indian politics and religions to uncover the secular meaning of the biblical text. For him, scripture is an arena of dialogue where social issues encounter the humanising power of the gospel.

George Douglas Scorgie

School Culture, Leadership and Language Development in a Chinese-International School

This thesis examined the impact of a Chinese cultural setting in an International school that sought to integrate a Western educational model. The research findings demonstrated a nexus between cultural identity, professional practice and social behaviour in the emergence of school culture and further contributed to knowledge of effective practices in leadership and bilingual immersion education.

Monique Therese Shephard

Expanding Mental Health Awareness in Adolescents Using Contemporary Young Adult Literature in the English Classroom

This research investigates how contemporary young adult literature used in English classrooms can engage adolescents in discussions around mental health. Students in this study appeal for greater support for mental health issues from peers, teachers, and carers. Findings suggest including mental health as a cross-curriculum priority in the Australian Curriculum and extending activities promoting mental health awareness to the home environment.

Helen Stavrou

Exploring the Impact of Popular Song and Sources of Popular Culture on the Learning Motivation of higher education EFL students.

What to do when English as Second language students are unmotivated to learn? Recognising students' enjoyment of popular music, Helen surveyed them about their pastimes, created curriculum to embrace those interests, then using Action Research positively impacted students' motivation and engagement. Ultimately, she produced a model – Sustained Motivation in Language Learning Environments (SMILLE) model incorporating popular song, TV and film as learning prompts.

Leslie Taylor

Were the early years of Australia a 'golden age' for convicted criminals?

An examination of sentencing in criminal cases in Britain and the early colony of Australia. The work looks at causes of crime in both places and compares the social consequences of harsh punishments. The argument is made that the colony was more alert to exacting chastisements being counterproductive with the colony reforming criminals by a more considerate regime.

Van Thi Hong Tran

Home language maintenance among Vietnamese-Australian families

This research explored home language maintenance among 151 Vietnamese-Australian families using Spolsky's language policy. Children's home language maintenance did not negatively impact English proficiency and was dependent on parents' language use, attitudes, and family language policies. This research raises awareness of the importance of families' home language maintenance to promote children's multilingualism in Australia and across the world.

Charles Uesile Tupu

Fa'a'ola Fanua: The Role of Public Theology in Taking Care of Customary Land (fanua faale-aganu'u)

This thesis stands within an emerging body of research into a public theology in the Samoan context. It depends upon the cultural metaphor of silag toga as it explores the pressure being brought to bear on customary land. It proceeds upon the basis of the need for a public theology that sits within a redemption rather than creation centred theology. It assumes the need for a more prophetic understanding of faith and a Christopraxis that flows from a re reading of the conventional understanding of Jesus Christ as saviour of the world the fa aola fanua.

Louisa Jane Waters

To Carry Fire: A Creative Critique of European Anthropogenic Fire Regimes on Gunnai Land

Louisa's research consists of an exhibition and exegesis exploring historical narratives of fire. Consulting closely with Wayne Thorpe, an Aboriginal elder from Gunnai Land in Gippsland, Victoria, Louisa critiques fire stories through the framework of landscape, history, ruins, and finally, listening. As her study was in progress Australia experienced the Black Summer bushfires in 2019-2020. Her creative practice research supports the global call for climate action.

This research indicated that there are complexities in determining and defining who is the true university customer. This thesis illustrates that there is a knowledge gap in the application of market orientation approaches in Australian universities.

Examination of the key factors driving business exit options in Australian Small and Medium Enterprises

This thesis explored the key drivers of business exit options for Australian business owners. Overall, the study highlights the influence of awareness, financial reward, and the involvement of both family and adviser on exit options. It contributes to a better understanding of exit options for business owners. This study will help improve business succession planning, particularly by baby boomers who own a significant portion of Australian businesses.

Instagram photo sharing and its relationship with social connectedness, loneliness and well-being

This study examined relationships among social media photo sharing, social connectedness, loneliness and well-being. It found sharing photos of oneself had a positive effect on social rewards and photo sharing moderated these relationships, e.g., high levels of social connectedness had the strongest effect on well-being when users engaged in higher levels of photo sharing. The study informs social media photo sharing best practice for future technology enhancement.

Doctor of Philosophy

John Charles Peter Edwards

Linking Sales Performance to Entrepreneurial Strategy-Making, Corporate Entrepreneurship Preparedness and Entrepreneurial Sales Actions

The research findings from a survey of 252 Australian B2B salespeople suggests that an entrepreneurial (bottom-up) strategy-making approach, is positively associated with preparing a firm's entrepreneurial climate, developing innovative actions, and ultimately better sales performance. This study contributes to the business literature by offering guidance to firms to employ entrepreneurial decision-making and innovative sales actions for improved sales performance.

Debra Ann Metcalf

Australian consumers' perceptions, attitudes, and behaviour toward a novel food: An evaluation using hemp food as an exemplar

Dr Metcalf examined how consumer perceptions of a novel food impact on their willingness to consume. Results showed that a single aspect of a new food, such as how an ingredient has been used in the past, can override other psychological evaluations of that food. The combination of methods used was innovative and findings will allow us to encourage people to consume healthy foods, even where past experiences may otherwise discourage consumption.

Adam Poulsen

The Investigation of a New Care Robot Design Approach for Alleviating LGBT+ Elderly Loneliness

Person-centred care and human values have remained largely unaccounted for in care robot design. This PhD study addressed this gap by employing value sensitive design and a case study exploring social robot interventions for older LGBT+ Australians experiencing loneliness. Based on its findings, it was possible to develop a new care robot design method and an understanding of the older LGBT+ population's social, care, and community values in relation to technology.

Nirmala Wati Singh

Female Entrepreneurs' Access to Bank Finance in Fiji: Challenges and Success Factors

This PhD used an extended 5M framework (money, market, management, motherhood, and individual characteristics meso/macro-environment) and a mixed research approach to explore the demand-side and supply-side challenges facing female entrepreneurs in Fiji. Research proposed the framework for overcoming challenges of access to bank finance and extended the application of traditional corporate finance theories in entrepreneurship, in the context of developing countries.

Doctor of Philosophy

Samar Mohamad Al-Share'

The perceptions and awareness of Australian pregnant and breastfeeding women of the risks/safety of complementary medicine products.

This research was undertaken across three groups: pregnant or lactating people and community pharmacists. Two-thirds of pregnant and over half of lactating participants identified their awareness of complementary medicines' safe use relied on perceptions of safety, efficacy, quality, brand differences from their own perceived capabilities in seeking knowledge. Pharmacists, as a group from whom study participants may seek advice, correctly identified products which are safe or contraindicated in the participant groups to enhance safe use.

Imtiaz Faruk Chowdhury

Microbial degradation of trifluralin and atrazine residues in soil

Pre-emergent herbicides are essential for weed control to allow better crop establishment. Their persistence in soil for extended periods may lead to soil and groundwater contamination. Long term persistence of herbicide residues near the surface may affect rotational crops. Imtiaz's work looked at crop sensitivity to two commonly used herbicides. His work identified optimal conditions for herbicide breakdown and the associated soil microbes.

Taiwo Esther Fasoyin

Food knowledge, beliefs, attitudes and behaviour among women of reproductive age group (18-49 years) towards consumption of green leafy vegetables in Delta State Nigeria

Study focused on green leafy vegetables, nutrition and the health of women of childbearing age. Most green leafy vegetables are yet unappreciated for their nutritional health values; hence not consumed despite being affordable and locally available. Adding to agricultural science Hons and Master of sustainable agriculture research, this PhD contributes data to advance health economics of micronutrients for women of reproductive age.

Kayla Jade Kopp

Altering pre-lambing nutrition to impact colostrum and milk production in ewes, immunity transfer and growth of lambs

The effect of altering pre-lambing nutrition on ewes and newborn lambs was investigated. Results demonstrated that milk production was increased with maize and methionine supplementation, although other supplements had no effect. A survey showed more than half of Australian producers are underestimating lamb mortality rates, suggesting improved knowledge is required to ensure producers are aware of losses and can implement practices to reduce reproductive wastage.

Nkemdilim Ifeanyi Obi

Study of the Impact of Gas Flaring on the Health of Communities in Delta region of Nigeria

Gas and oil operations including gas flaring impact on health. This was a cross-sectional mixed method study involving communities, government and oil companies to provide insight into effects of gas flaring on health and contributes to gender and generational gap in discourse of environmental issues. The study recommends governments and oil firms to implement measures to reduce flaring and for host populations to be educated on health consequences of gas flaring.

Joshua Michael Scherpenhuizen

Evaluation of the welfare and reproductive biology of captive tigers using non-invasive techniques: Behaviour and hormone monitoring

With tigers facing extinction in the wild, never has the need to maintain a viable and robust captive population been more important. By monitoring hormones and behaviour from a large number of tigers over a long period of time, Josh was able to provide a new insight as to how tigers fare in captivity. Josh's work revealed important facility and management considerations, and the application of this research will result in better welfare for captive tigers.

Emily Isabella Thomas

Impact and causes of non-pollination-drop of walnut flowers (Juglans regia) in a semi-arid climate of Australia.

Non-pollination-drop (NPD), a form of premature fruit drop caused by failed reproduction, reduces walnut yield in Australian semi-arid climate regions. Hot dry weather during flowering was found to be the primary driver of NPD, reducing pollen viability and stigma receptivity of the female walnut flower, limiting the chances of fruit set. This research will facilitate the development of management strategies for NPD in walnut production.

Vi An Vu

Diversity in migration patterns of selected Mekong River fishes

Understanding Mekong fish migrations is important to protect an important resource from the impacts of river development. This research focused on understanding the migration strategy of 10 socially and economically important fish species. The work identified that connections between the river and the sea is important but is threatened by dam construction. The work justifies the inclusion of fish migration mitigation strategies into future dam projects.

Kin Fai Bosco Wan

The Use of Telephone Counselling to Improve Medicine Beliefs and Adherence Among Hospital Out-patients in Hong Kong

This study examined pharmacist-led telephone counselling to improve medicine beliefs and adherence among hospital out-patients in Hong Kong. It was mostly beneficial but younger females, taking less medicine, for shorter periods were less likely to believe in their medication, while older patients, who were hesitant in taking medicines gained most benefit. Asking 'how do you consider your general health' could identify those sceptical of their medication.
