Session Subject site checklist:

- Learning Materials (Content) are fit for purpose → provisioned from the
 Master site
- Assessment 'shells' are available, but may not have been 'deployed' yet
- Students have been enrolled into the subject site (Course Admin → Classlist), sections (cohorts) will be in place
- Discussion forum structure may have been established if so, no prior student posts
- That you have been added to the subject site (or have access to a sandbox)

Note. Staff can request a Brightspace Sandbox via

<u>Cherwell</u> (service request ticket → Brightspace → Sandbox)


Subject Outline Tool (SOT)

Subject Outline Tool (i.e. drafting, QA etc.):

- located on Brightspace Home Page Nav, and
- within the 'Staff Links' widget
- 'Submission method options' field has been removed from SOT
- Consideration re. 'Learning, teaching and support strategies' section

Live Subject Outlines (students and staff):

- located in the <u>Session subject site</u> (S-SUBJECTCODE_session)
- under 'My Subject' → 'Subject Outline'
- Automatically displays the relevant cohort outline (multiple for staff)



Subject Experience Survey (SuES)

Behaves in the following manner:

- Located within Session subject sites under 'My Subject'
- Staff also able to access the tool via 'Staff Links' (Brightspace home)
- Same tool + functionality currently utilised in Interact2

Reminder: the survey becomes 'live' three (3) weeks prior to the end of session and closes one week after the end of session.







Groups Management

Creation and Management of learner groups:

- Located under the 'Communication' menu (or via Course Admin → Learner Management)
- Process begins with creating a category for your groups (i.e. 'group set')
- Various enrolment 'types'
- Can be restricted (e.g. to cohorts / sections)
- Max 200 members / group








Learning Sequences: the Manage Dates tool

Course Admin → **Site Resources** → **Manage Dates**

- Bulk edit due dates / availability dates within the subject duration
- Affects all content types, assessment and discussions
- Filterable to 'tool' types (e.g. announcements, assignments, quizzes etc.)
- Bulk Edit Dates / Bulk 'Offset' Dates feature




Brightspace Checklist tool


Your existing learning material structure may benefit from checklists to help consolidate learning.

To create a new checklist:

- Instructor view locate module / sub-folder
- 'Add new' Checklist
- Populate name (visible to students in your content tool)
- Populate description (instructions?)
- Define categories (subheadings), if desired
- Populate checklist items
- Determine release conditions, if desired

Note. Remember the 'visibility' toggle - check in the Learner view






IVT & non IVT Lecture Capture (Panopto vs Zoom)


Recordings made in physical teaching spaces (IVT & nonIVT):

- Booking processes remain the same
- Zoom (IVT) recordings result in the recording link emailed to the instructor, then need to be provided to the student → create a discussion forum / topic
- Panopto (nonIVT) recordings will be captured within the <u>Session Subject site</u> (My Subject → CSU Replay (Panopto))
- Any Panopto recordings required for ongoing use (i.e. subsequent sessions) will need to be copied into the subject's 'Master Panopto Folder' (<u>link</u>)







Online Meetings (Zoom)

Behaves in the following ways:

- Same interface as the Zoom LTI used in Interact2 (Blackboard)
- Displays upcoming + previous meeting details (incl. Join link)
- Gives the instructor access to attendance / activity reports
- Cloud recordings (can toggle publish visibility)
- Joining via the subject site for both staff and students (check sign in via zoom desktop app)
- 365 day 'use-by' on recordings → download and provision elsewhere if required.







Class Progress: accessing learner data

Located within 'My Subject', this live report provides insight into learner activity:

- Full class dashboard filterable (incl. by cohorts / sections)
- Customisable progress indicators (via settings)
- Can connect to 'Agents' (automated actions email)
- Individual snapshot IS available to students
- Individual progress reports printable





Insights Portal: learning analytics dashboard (tbc)

Customisable dashboards:

- Subject-level engagement
- Learner engagement across multiple subjects
- Assessment efficacy
- Testing in progress
