Student Survey Results for 2025



Key Themes

Awareness of Student Services and Amenities Fee increased across all student cohorts.

The top themes by student priority for what students want to see SSAF spent on are:

1. Club, Events and Social Connection
2. Food and Essentials
3. Mental Health and Wellbeing
4. Online Student Support
5. Campus Facilities and Infrastructure
6. Career and Employability Support
7. Study Support
8. Financial Assistance and Equity



The key insights indicated by students are:

- Social connection and student-led activities are the most valued, suggesting students want more opportunities to engage and build community.
- Food security and support is a major priority, especially during exams and for students facing financial hardship.
- Mental health and wellbeing services are seen as essential, with many students requesting expanded access.
- Online students feel undeserved and advocate for more tailored services.
- Campus infrastructure like study spaces, sports facilities, and safe environment are also high priorities.
