

## CSU Replay Panopto– What has changed?

### CSU REPLAY – WHAT HAS CHANGED?

With the move of CSU Replay from using the Echo360 System Server to using Panopto, some things will look a little different, but some things will stay the same. Here is a short summary of the new service.

#### What's staying the same?

1. **You need to complete a [Learning and Teaching Form](#)** in order to have lectures recorded in a CSU Replay enabled teaching space. If you want to record content from your computer and do not want to record in a teaching space, you can just enable the CSU Replay tool in Interact2 and this will automatically provision the service on the CSU Replay Panopto server. You can also enable the CSU Replay tool now in Interact2 organisation sites.
2. **You have to enable the tool in Interact2** so that recordings can be made and are able to be accessed by other people enrolled in the Interact2 site, but the tool will have a different name. The tool is now called the **Panopto Course Tool Application** and will be available for your Interact2 site on 30<sup>th</sup> October.

#### What's New?

1. **Access to CSU Replay is determined by the enrolment in the Interact2 course.** Someone enrolled as an Instructor will have the ability to create content in the CSU Replay site for the course, and someone enrolled as a Student will have viewer access.  
*NB. An instructor can add another staff member as an instructor in the users section of the Interact2 site if they wish to have that other staff able to upload content to the course.*
2. **All main aspects of your CSU Replay videos are controlled directly in Interact2.** You can edit, upload, record, see statistics, change the order of recordings and manage settings directly from within the CSU Replay link in Interact2.
3. **The Personal Capture software is changing to Panopto recorder software.** The Echo Personal Capture software will no longer work with the CSU Replay environment and is being replaced with the Panopto Recorder software. This software will be available to install on CSU managed PCs and Macs via the Install Software icon on these computers, and is available for download inside the CSU Replay Interact2 link when you press the create button.

4. **In CSU Replay enabled teaching spaces we are changing the way that staff will be able to see that a recording is happening**, and how they can control the recording (pause, resume or stop) by the use of a small round light that will be installed in the lecterns of the teaching space. This light is a push button switch which turns green when a scheduled recording starts, and turns yellow when you press the switch once to show that the recording has paused. Recordings can be stopped by pressing and holding down the light for approx. 5 seconds.
5. **The recording software will record any input into the room**, such as a document camera, Windows laptop or AV computer. Please remember that as recordings in these spaces are scheduled, the CSU Replay [Learning and Teaching Form](#) will need to be completed at least 2 business days prior to the event.
6. **Embedding a recording into a module is significantly easier** and can be accomplished using the mashup tool in Interact2. Click on the mashup tool and select the Panopto Video option to bring up a picker to select a video from the CSU Replay link for your course that you want to add. No more fiddling with HTML code to embed the recording.
7. The new CSU Replay service has a lot of great new features such as a **powerful search** that can search across all the recordings for a word that appears on a slide, in a note that the student has taken, a bookmark they have made, a discussion or even if the word is spoken in the recording, making it easier to re-watch specific parts of videos.
8. **Editing is vastly improved** and can be accessed directly from the CSU Replay Interact2 link. You can even insert a YouTube clip in the middle of a recording.

**Please also note:**

1. Learning and Teaching content recorded in CSU Replay subject sites for the 201690, 201730 and 201760 sites will be migrated across to an archive on the server so that you can copy content recorded this year in CSU Replay to new courses.
2. Introductory training courses are being run throughout October and through to mid-November this year and will recommence in mid-January of 2018 for staff. Please check Whats New for the training session dates and times.
