

Multi-Factor Authentication for VDI Access Quick Start Guide

Introduction

This guide will assist you with accessing Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) at Charles Sturt University. CSU uses VMWare Horizon for its VDI, which requires MFA with Duo Security to access.

Before accessing VDI at Charles Sturt University, you must first enrol a device for MFA. If you have already enrolled a device for Duo MFA, you can skip to Setting up VDI.



Setup VMWare Horizon

Download & Install VMWare Horizon VDI	Click here to download the VMWare Horizon client from their website for Mac or Windows. Double click on the downloaded installer once finished, and follow the installation steps. Click here for detailed instructions on how to download and install the

2. Once installed, find and open the VMWare Horizon Client Click + Add Server and enter vdi.csu.edu.au before clicking Connect	Name of the Connection Server vdi.csu.edu.au Cancel Connect
Enter your CSU username and password before pressing Login	Enter your CSU user name and passcode. User name
Enter the word push and click Login on the next prompt for a secondary factor. Accept the Duo prompt on your phone	Choose a secondary factor from ('push1', 'phone1', 'sms1') or enter passcode: Cancel Login
