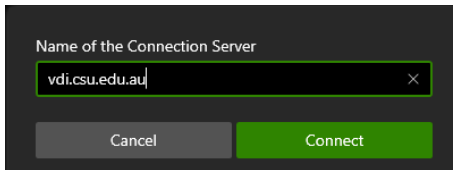
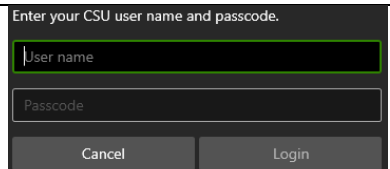
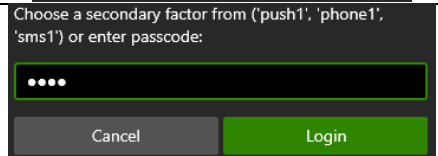
Introduction

This guide will assist you with accessing Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) at Charles Sturt University. CSU uses VMWare Horizon for its VDI, which requires MFA with Duo Security to access.

Before accessing VDI at Charles Sturt University, you must first enrol a device for MFA. If you have already enrolled a device for Duo MFA, you can skip to [Setting up VDI](#).


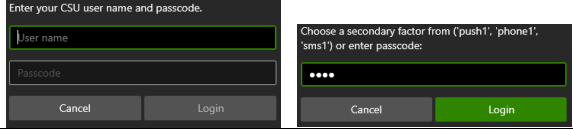

Setup VMWare Horizon

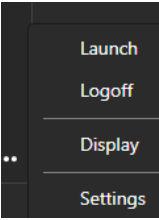
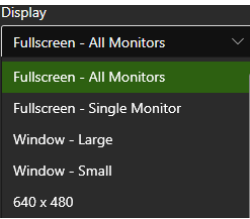
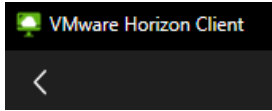
1. Download & Install VMWare Horizon VDI	Click here to download the VMWare Horizon client from their website for Mac or Windows. Double click on the downloaded installer once finished, and follow the installation steps. Click here for detailed instructions on how to download and install the VMWare Horizon client.
2. Once installed, find and open the VMWare Horizon Client  Click  and enter vdi.csu.edu.au before clicking Connect	
3. Enter your CSU username and password before pressing Login	
4. Enter the word push and click Login on the next prompt for a secondary factor. Accept the Duo prompt on your phone	

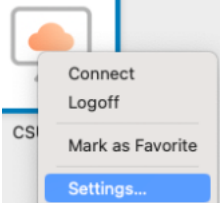



Logging into VDI

1. In the VMWare Horizon Client, double click on the vdv.csu.edu.au tile	
2. Login with your username and password and Duo prompt as shown above	
3. Double click on the CSU Student/Staff tile The VDI session will now open	
<p>NOTE: VMWare Horizon will default to a full screen mode for a seamless experience. You can exit full screen mode to make it a smaller resizable window on your computer or minimise the VDI session by clicking Exit Fullscreen or the minimise icon in the toolbar at the top of the screen respectively:</p>

1. Right click on the CSU Student/Staff tile and select Settings .	2. Click on the dropdown menu under Display and select the desired option from the list.	3. Click the < button at the top left to return to the main menu.
	 <p>Note: You can also disable/enable display scaling here using the respective toggle to resolve any issues with large/ small elements in VDI.</p>	

MacOS		
1. Right click on the CSU Student/Staff tile and select Settings .	2. Click on the Resolution dropdown menu under the Display tab and select the desired option from the list.	3. Close the Settings menu to return to the main menu.
	 <p>Note: You can also change the scaling here with the respective dropdown to resolve any issues with large/small elements in VDI.</p>
