GrantEd Program

What is the *GrantEd* Program?

Are you planning to write a grant application in 2023? Make a plan as part of your EDRS to participate in the *GrantEd* program.

The *Granted* program provides training in grant writing and development for early- and mid-career researchers.

The program, developed by Dr Anna Hutchens from [Postdoc Solutions Online](#), combines an online course with practical guidance to develop and write a full grant proposal. A dedicated facilitator will give participants personal support, mentoring, and strategic advice during the program.

There are limited places in this program (maximum of 10 funded seats). Preference will be given to applicants who are grant-ready.

How is the program structured?

The *GrantEd* 2023 program starts 27 March 2023. There are three parts to the program.

1. Online course	Participants will complete six online modules over 8-week weeks (until Friday 26 May). <i>Module 1 – Get Grant Ready</i> <i>Module 2 – Ready, Set, Write</i> <i>Module 3 – Online Q & A Week</i> <i>Module 4 – Feedback Fest</i> <i>Module 5 – Feedback Integration</i> <i>Module 6 – Post-Submission Professionalism</i>
2. Draft grant proposal	Participants will apply what they learnt to develop a draft grant proposal for their targeted funding scheme within 6 months.
3. Coaching session*	Following the completion of a draft proposal, participants will receive a one-on-one coaching session for feedback on their grant application.

***Participants are expected to successfully complete all course modules and associated tasks, develop a draft proposal, and participate fully with the program to be considered for the one-on-one coaching session.**

Who is eligible to apply?

The *GrantEd* program is open to Charles Sturt early- and mid-career staff who:

- Are research-focused, or teaching/research Level A-C.
- Hold a continuing appointment at Charles Sturt University, or a fixed term appointment until 31 December 2025.
- Have been awarded a PhD.
- Have an identified targeted funding scheme.
- Have support from their Head of School or Research Institute Director to undertake the program.
- Have time to spend time developing their proposal and can commit to successfully completing the program within 6 months (average 4 hours per week).

How do I apply?
