



## Granted Program (commencing 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022)

Write a **stand-out** research grant proposal.

**Ahead** of the deadline.

With **expert mentoring** and **strategic advice** while you write.

And a **tribe** to support you.

### Overview

The 'Granted' program provides training in grant writing and development, being offered to early- and mid-career researchers in 2022. The program combines an online course with practical guidance to develop and write a full grant proposal. A dedicated facilitator will give participants personal support, mentoring, and strategic advice during the program.

There are limited places in this program (maximum of 10 funded seats).

### Structure of the program

Online course	<p>Participants will complete a series of six online modules structured over an 8-week program, <u>commencing 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022</u>.</p> <p>There are six modules in the program:</p> <p>Module 1 – Get Grant Ready  Module 2 – Ready, Set, Write  Module 3 – Online Q &amp; A Week  Module 4 – Feedback Fest  Module 5 – Feedback Integration  Module 6 – Post-Submission Professionalism</p> <p>Extended access to online modules allows participants to complete in their own time.</p>
Draft grant proposal	Participants will apply what they learnt in the online course to develop a draft grant proposal for a target funding scheme within 12 months.
Coaching session*	Following the completion of a draft proposal, participants will receive a one-on-one coaching session for feedback.

*\*Participants are expected to successfully complete all course modules and associated tasks, develop a draft proposal, and participate fully with the program to be considered for the one-on-one coaching session.*

## Eligibility

- Open to CSU Academic Staff (Research-focussed, or Teaching/Research) Level A-C.
- Holds a continuing appointment at CSU, or a fixed term appointment until 31 December 2024.
- Holds a PhD.
- Has the support of their Head of School or Research Centre Director to undertake the program.
- Is willing to spend time studying and developing a proposal in order to successfully complete the program.

As seats are limited, preference will be given to applicants who are grant-ready.
