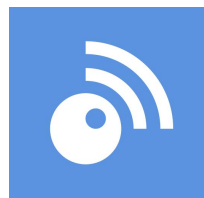



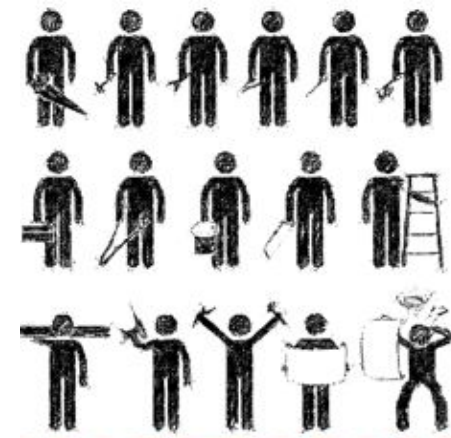

(Feeds | Distribution | Work | Leisure)

Pocket Casts (free)

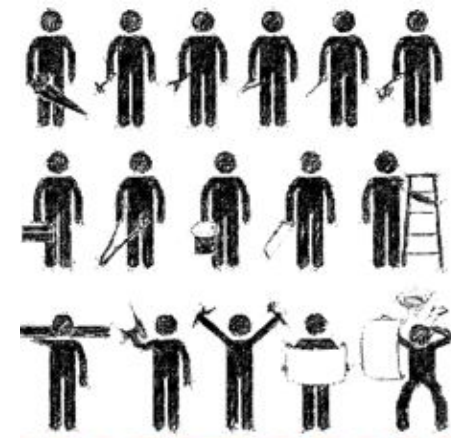
- Mobile App only
- Clean, intuitive UI

Inoreader - <https://inoreader.com>

- Web + App Feed Reader / Aggregator
- No frills - RSS, Facebook, Reddit, Twitter or Newsletters
- Library function (starred / favourite content)
- Free (limitation on number of feeds - 5)

Podbean - <https://podbean.com>

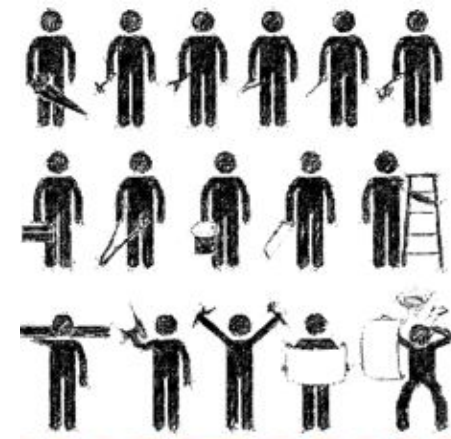
- Distribution platform only
- Free account - 5 hours audio cap



Teaching Ideas

..work back from either 'embedded / subscribed to'

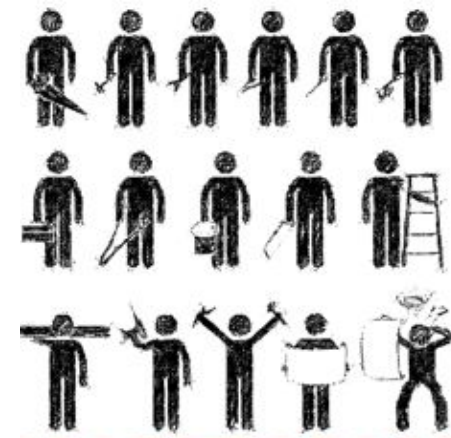
- Weekly updates
- Concept lectures (audio bites)
- Instructor breakdown of assessment
- Cohort feedback on assessment
- 'Plan of attack' for weekly learning materials / experiences
- Response to readings?
- Student podcasts? / episodic reflections?



Tips n Tricks

..you will be invoiced shortly for these at the standard rate.

- Pacing! (listen to your recorded voice to get an appreciation of just how fast you're speaking)
- Authenticity > production (every time)
- Don't get lost in transitions (see above)
- RSS - figure out what is ok for students to subscribe to and organise your recordings appropriately
- Include your podcast details as part of your info for students (e.g. subject welcome / getting started)

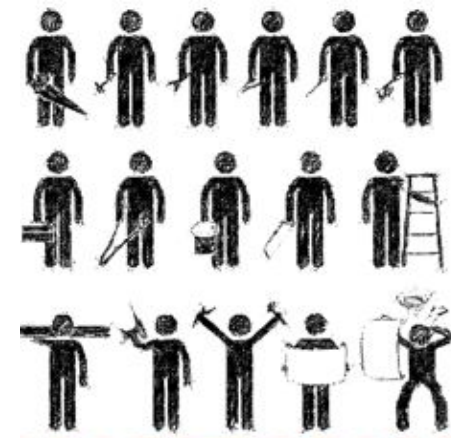
