## 3 Work together

Consider joining an academic integrity community of practice, such as the Australian Academic Integrity Network (AAIN), to share resources and intelligence with others in the sector.

## 2 Grow a positive academic integrity culture

Continue conversations about cheating and ethics beyond inductions or O-week. It could be with a dedicated academic integrity week, student competitions or even creative showcases.

## 4 Have a strong, up-to-date academic integrity policy

Keep your academic integrity policies and procedures updated to address emerging integrity threats. Procedures must be clear so that staff and students understand what happens if an academic integrity breach is suspected.

## 5 Train your staff on academic integrity

Your staff will come from diverse backgrounds, so you cannot assume prior knowledge. Provide them with academic integrity training and resources and refresh these when new integrity threats emerge.

## 6 Review and refresh your assessments regularly

Help prevent cheating by supporting teaching staff to review and refresh their assessments each teaching period, and not recycle assessment tasks from other courses or institutions.

## 7 Engage and educate students on academic integrity

Make understanding academic integrity accessible to all students with clear, inclusive resources defining academic misconduct, how to maintain academic integrity and the risks of using commercial academic cheating services.

## 8 Record and report on academic integrity

Maintain clear reporting processes at your institution. Document detection rates and outcomes of academic misconduct. Consider making these reports public.

## 9 Provide a supportive learning environment

Make students aware of the support services you offer and that these are available to all students, regardless of their accessibility needs or location.

## 10 Report suspected academic cheating services
