

Business in Vietnam

Indicative program outline: This itinerary is subject to change and should be used as a guide only.

Day	Activity
1	All participants must have arrived in Hanoi by this date and checked-in accommodation.
2	AM: The program will start with orientation and a walking tour before undertaking your first Vietnamese language class
	PM: Take the afternoon to explore your neighbourhood.
3	AM: Enjoy a cruise of Halong Bay
	PM: Spend the afternoon kayaking through the floating villages before returning to Hanoi
4	AM: You will visit the Australian Embassy
	PM: Another walking tour of Hanoi will get you more familiarised with the city and its culture
5	AM: This morning you'll visit the first of several industry organisations. This could be financial, law or accounting institutions where you'll learn about how to conduct business and finance in the region
	PM: In the afternoon you'll visit a local NGO for their perspective of finance and business from a non-government perspective. This could also include a presentation and/or workshops
6	AM: A visit to a local university to meet staff and students and attend lectures will start your day. You'll also keep building your local communications skills with another language class.
	PM: Spend the afternoon practicing your Vietnamese by exploring Hanoi. Dinner with your new University colleagues will close the day.
7	Free day in Hanoi
8	Free day In Hanoi
9	AM: You'll travel to ancient Duong Lam Village for a cycling tour of the village, have lunch at a local home, meet with a local of the village who will illuminate the area's history and traditions and attend a traditional cooking class PM: Travel back to Hanoi and spend the evening at your leisure
10	AM: You'll visit another industry organisation - financial, law or accounting - this morning to explore finance and
	business practices further PM: Cultural activities will complete the afternoon with visits to the Fine Arts and Women's Museums. In the evening you'll attend a water puppet show and have dinner together at a local eatery
11	AM: Visit Dong Xuan Market today (the largest wholesale market in the North) where you'll get to observe this local trade centre and enjoy some shopping.
	PM: In the afternoon you'll visit a local NGO for their perspective of finance and business from a non-government perspective. This could also include a presentation and/or workshops
12	AM: You'll visit another industry organisation - financial, law or accounting - this morning to explore finance and business practices further
	PM: A special lecture (or similar activity) from an industry expert will be delivered
13	AM: Another visit to a local university to meet staff and students will allow you to further understand theoretical principals of finance and business
	PM: Program wrap up and farewell dinner
