

Subject: What's New in Brightspace – May, 2024: Roles, Bulk Enrolments + more

Dear colleagues,

We're well under way in preparations for Session 2/60 and excited about helping staff and students transition to Brightspace for the start of teaching and learning. Updates are being introduced into Brightspace from today, as summarised below:

Updates to the Production Environment:

Roles:

- Teaching Staff role: The ability to edit grade items will be removed.
- Teaching Staff (Additional) and Appointed Lecturer role: 'Teaching Staff (Additional)' and 'Appointed Lecturer' roles currently have identical permissions. 'Teaching Staff (Additional)' will be removed, with those allocated to that role transferred to Appointed Lecturer.
- Faculty and School Administration role: is now available for Faculty Admin Managers, Subject Admin Managers, Heads of School and senior faculty administration, with the ability to add staff in ACSES from next week.
- Please refer to our <u>Roles and Permissions guidance</u> for more information.

Bulk enrolments for organisation sites:

- Bulk Enrolment functionality is being enabled for organisation sites, allowing staff with the appropriate access to upload lists of new users to the site.
- Staff who require support to carry out this operation are asked to contact the Polaris email inbox in the first instance.
- Note: in subject and course sites, enrolment of new users is primarily managed via the Banner integration.

Integrate Zoom to the Calendar:

- An issue was identified where Zoom meetings were not creating Brightspace calendar entries.
- This has been corrected, with Zoom meetings now created directly within the Brightspace calendar using the Zoom LTI.

Gradebook

 Gradebook is getting easier to read with the removal of the duplicate Final Calculated Grade column

Subject experience survey (Course Evals)

 The Subject Experience Survey link has been added to the 'My Subject' dropdown on the subject site navigation bar, called 'Subject Survey'.




Image: 'Subject Survey' drop down under 'My Subject' in navbar.
