## Peer review of teaching practice for probation

This template will guide the peer review of teaching required as part of the Foundations of Learning and Teaching at Charles Sturt program. The following steps outline the peer review process:

- 1. The **reviewee** selects **two** teaching capabilities to be reviewed.
- 2. The **reviewee** organises an initial meeting with the peer reviewer to plan the review, discuss the capabilities and consider timeframes.
- 3. The **reviewee reflects on their selected capabilities**, records their reflections on the template and documents their initial evidence against the selected capabilities.
- 4. The **reviewee and reviewer** liaise to conduct the peer review.
- 5. Once completed, the **reviewer emails the completed and signed report** to the Foundations of Learning and Teaching at Charles Sturt team.


