**Citation for the conferral of the honorary award or title of Emeritus
Professor upon Professor Clement Wayne Hudson**

Professor Wayne Hudson has made a significant and ongoing contribution to the work of the Australian Centre for Christianity and Culture, Public and Contextual Theology Research Centre (PaCT) and its successor the Centre for Religion, Ethics and Society at Charles Sturt University. This has manifested in regular high quality contributions to seminar and teaching programs, mentorship, public lectures and PhD supervision. He continues to publish at the highest level with significant disciplinary impact as his elevation to the Australian Academy of the Humanities attests.

Professor Hudson was elected to the Australian Academy of the Humanities for his work on connections between religion, utopianism and modernity earlier this year. With outstanding contributions to Australian historiography, his work ranges from the exploration of republicanism and citizenship in Australia, the role of Deism in the Enlightenment, to the interpretation of the utopian philosophy. Election to the Australian Academy of Humanities is the highest honour for achievement in and contribution to the humanities in Australia. I recommend him for an Emeritus Professorship without hesitation. He is a world class scholar who has made an outstanding contribution to Charles Sturt University and his discipline.
