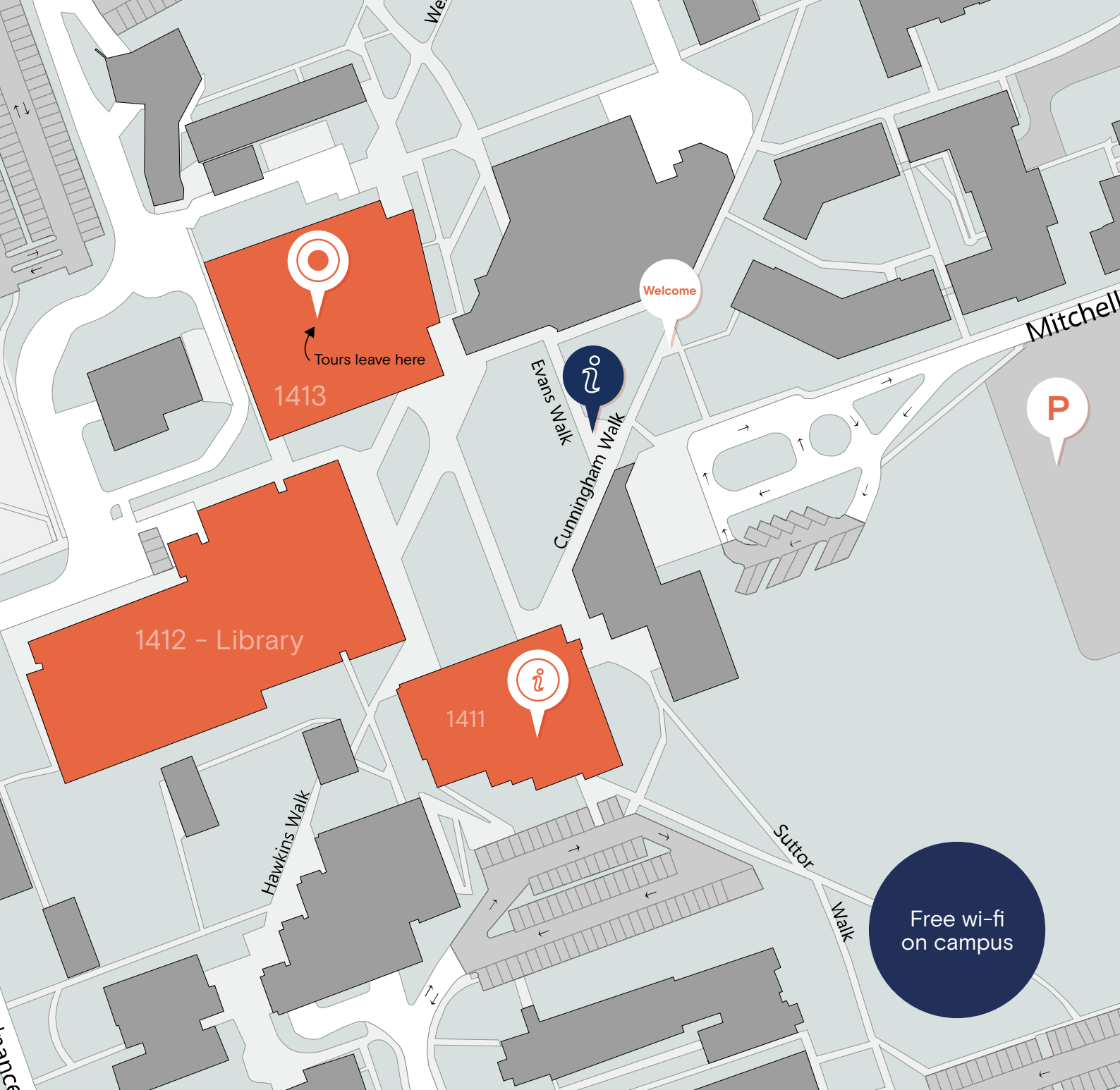
On Open Day, the Expo Hub is where it's at.
