The Charles Sturt University (CSU) Regional Leadership Program will help you develop the skills you need to lead effectively, with a focus on interacting with colleagues, managing projects and creating dynamic work environments.

You will identify and practice key communication, motivation, delegation and problem-solving skills, to reach your own potential and maximise that of your staff. Case studies relevant to regional Australia will form part of the program content.

You will learn how to:

- assess your leadership capabilities, effectiveness, strengths and weaknesses
- analyse your personal leadership style and how this affects others
- understand the requirements of your team and develop their capacity and cohesiveness
- engage your team by building an environment that motivates them
- practice strong project management and use projects as a mechanism for change
- comprehend financial management and how to apply budgets as living documents
- coach your team to improve performance, manage workplace diversity and resolve conflicts

Module topics:

- ethical and effective leadership
- managing yourself and others
- financial and project management
- governance and compliance
- organisational behaviour

Modules consist of a two-day face-to-face workshop and assessment.

This program also acts as a pathway for graduates of the AVCLP.

Successful completion of the course can offer pathways to the CSU *Graduate Certificate in Business Leadership* or *Masters of Business Leadership*.
