	Theme 1: Early childhood interdisciplinary practice in regional Australia
	In this theme we explore models of interdisciplinary practice in the first 2000 days and how successful models could be translated to optimise outcomes for infants and children in regional Australia. We explore commonalities of language in optimizing interdisciplinary practice in the early years and innovative interdisciplinary strategies to enhance recruitment and retention of early years professionals in regional Australia.
	Theme 2: Children's communication
