Our ethos, 'yindyamarra winhanganha' has been at the heart of Charles Sturt's story since day one. With a history that stretches back more than 125 years, we began as a humble vocational farm at Bathurst, dedicated to empowering rural people with essential skills and education.

Fast forward through the decades and we established agricultural and teaching centres in Wagga Wagga and Bathurst, sharing knowledge so people could uplift their futures and communities.

In 1989, Charles Sturt made its grand debut as a university, named after the British soldier Charles Napier Sturt, who sailed to New South Wales in 1827 to pursue his passion for exploration.

Since then, we've been on an exciting growth journey, opening doors to quality university education for students in regional Australia, with campuses in Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange, Port Macquarie and Wagga Wagga. But we didn't stop there! We also have study hubs located in Canberra, Goulburn, Parramatta, Melbourne, Sydney and Wangaratta, and our online courses reach people across the globe.

What to expect

The day you've been waiting for has finally arrived. After all your efforts, time and dedication, you're ready to graduate!

How does it work?

The Academic Senate recommends students to be admitted to degrees. These soon-to-be grads (also known as graduands) have successfully completed their coursework and passed the required exams. The University Council formally admits the graduands, approving conferral of award as graduates.

About the ceremony

University medals

Undergraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a bachelor's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Postgraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a coursework master's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Higher Degree by Research University Medal

Awarded to one doctoral and one master's by research graduate per faculty. At least two examiners must indicate that the graduate's thesis is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Bachelor Honours University Medal

Awarded to one honours graduate per faculty, who has completed at least 64 points of study in the course at the university, and who has achieved Class 1 as an overall grade for the honours course. At least one examiner must indicate that the student's thesis or dissertation is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Charles Sturt Medal

Awarded to one graduate annually who has both an outstanding academic achievement (including a GPA of 6.75 or higher), and has demonstrated a significant contribution to the public good consistent with the university's motto 'for the public good'.

The university mace

The Charles Sturt mace is the symbol of the university as an independent academy of scholars constituted under legal authority.

The mace is crafted from timbers indigenous to the locations of Charles Sturt campuses. It reflects the traditions and authority of the university, and symbolises its multiple geographies and responsibilities to the people of rural and regional Australia.



The university message stick

A gift from Dubbo Regional Council, this wooden message stick draws on elements of local indigenous culture to represent the Wiradjuri nation, whose borders encompass our campuses at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange and Wagga Wagga.

























Young and old emu feathers, which hang from the mulga wood message stick, denote students of all ages. A possum painting represents the local Wilay Wiradjuri people and red ochre lines depict the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers on which the university's Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga campuses are located.

John James Barnaby

A Psychodynamic approach to assisting individuals who struggle with Obsessionality and Compulsivity

Obsessive compulsive disorder is a severely disabling chronic condition that affects approximately one in fifty people. Prescribed treatment, exposure and response prevention, is of limited effectiveness yet psychodynamic models are dismissed. Arguing that validity is reflected in utility rather than randomised controlled trials, it is proposed that contemporary psychodynamic psychotherapy offers both complementary and alternative treatment strategies

Nicholas David Brooke Gahan

Sirens to silence: Examining the experiences of firefighters transitioning into and living in retirement.

Firefighting careers can end suddenly due to mandated medical or age-based retirement. In this context, retirement is dreaded. This qualitative research explored the lived experiences of 27 retired and retiring firefighters. Thematic analysis identified key themes through emphasising storytelling in participant-led interviews, including unique challenges retiring firefighters face. Eight recommendations for fire services to transform retirement conclude the study.

Juana Eletha Katzer

Social Workers' Decision-Making Processes with Children who Exhibited Problem Sexualised Behaviours

The study found that complex child and family characteristics, along with social worker and organisational factors, influenced decision-making. Practice with these children focused on building non-stigmatising relationships and addressing their needs, risks, and safety. The analysis has implications for policy and practice, including development of a national framework, assessment and practice guidelines, and education, training, and further research.

Serena Claire Mathews

Exploring Social Work Practice in Regional and Remote Australia in the Field of Trauma

Social workers in trauma settings in rural and remote Australia face greater complexities than their urban colleagues. This qualitative research explored the lived experiences of twelve social work practitioners. Data analysis identified themes that foster and/or hinder participants in their work. The study presents unique insights and recommendations that will contribute positively to social workers' longevity in trauma settings in regional and remote Australia.

Doctor of Philosophy

Ikramullah Ahmed

Sighting the Moon for Ramadan and Eid; A critical Evaluation of Diverse Islamic Legal Views and Practices of Muslims in Australia

This study explores the issue of moonsighting from a classical perspective, based on the Qur'an, Ḥadīth (Prophetic Narrations), and Islamic Jurisprudence. A national survey was also conducted with over 5,500 responses from individuals and leaders across Australia. The high response rate reflected strong community interest in how Ramaḍān and 'Eid are determined. The data was analysed to understand current and past moonsighting practices among Australian Muslims.

Bing Chung Au

Ecclesial and Divine Judgment in 1 Corinthians 5:1-6:11: A Comparative-Exegetical Study in Light of Roman Legal Contexts

In 1 Corinthians 5 and 6, the apostle Paul responds to several practical scenarios that have impacted the Christian community in Corinth. Au contends that exploring key principles within the Roman legal tradition, such as clemency, public interest, and arbitration, illuminates the historical and theological relevance of Paul's rhetoric. He suggests that Paul's use of judgment language both compares and contrasts with key legal principles in the wider Roman context.

Jason Cummings

Teacher preparation and professional language development: Do pre-service teachers develop a professional language for inclusive classroom teaching practice?

This research examined the effectiveness of teacher preparation. Australian, Scottish, and New Zealand teacher accreditation standards were employed to validate an instrument for measuring the professional language (PL) of students attending universities in those jurisdictions. Over 95% of pre-service teachers did not develop an understanding of the PL required for inclusive teaching calling into question the effectiveness of their preparation for PL development.

Jennifer Anne Dwyer

Children's mathematical graphics: Making mathematical connections with their world

This study revealed children's understanding of mathematical concepts through their mathematical graphics in creative and imaginative ways. Instead of seeing scribbles or realism within children's drawings, children's mathematical graphics express mathematical ideas influenced by their connections to their socio-cultural and spatial-physical environments. It highlights the importance of educators seeing children's symbolic processes of knowing mathematical concepts.

Maslathif Dwi Purnomo

Multimodal stance-taking in the genre of presidential address: A case of the seventh Indonesian president, Joko Widodo

This thesis explores the interplay between multimodality and stance in the presidential addresses of Indonesia's 7th president, Joko Widodo, as a case study. It analyses how mobile and stationary modes shape stance-taking, including evaluation, positioning, and alignment. The findings reveal distinct yet intriguing mode preferences in conveying affective, epistemic, and effective stances in the evolving political genre of presidential discourse.

Examining Thai students' intentions to enrol in Australian higher education institutions using country and university brand image.

International students' decision to study abroad is complex. However, a way to increase student numbers is better marketing. The aim of this study was to examine factors influencing Thai postgraduate students' intentions to enrol in Australian universities. The key finding is that a university's brand image is the most important factor. Thus, this study recommends that to increase enrolment from Thai students, universities should focus on building their brand image.

Brett Kevin Henderson

Sharing Responsibility for Emergency Management: a community perspective.

A case study of the Eurobodalla NSW experience of emergency management in the Black Summer fires of 2019/20 found inefficiencies of bureaucracies designed to manage and coordinate emergencies. It identified wholesale changes are required to NSW emergency management legislation to ensure community can be endorsed stakeholders in all facets of emergency management, and recommends significant changes in the power structures that dominate emergency management in NSW.

Doctor of Philosophy

Afra Azzahra

Examining the Role of Financial Intelligence in Preventing, Disrupting, and Reducing Child Sex Trafficking

The research explores how financial intelligence can help disrupt child sex trafficking by tracking illicit financial flows, disrupting perpetrators and their networks. The research underscores that financial intelligence has a significant impact on anti-trafficking efforts, informing policy and practice to better protect vulnerable children. Improved information sharing among intelligence stakeholders can enhance child sex trafficking prevention in Indonesia.

Sheree Nicole Moore

Family and Domestic Violence in Australian Rural Emergency Departments: A critical analysis of institutional discourses and narratives

Despite severity little is known about FDV in rural areas and whether EDs respond effectively. This qualitative discursive study analysed policy, and observations and focus groups at two EDs. Results found Deficit Subject and Societal Narratives encouraged stereotypical assumptions that could disempower and reduce chances that FDV would be identified or prioritised – particularly for certain groups, including First Nations Peoples and LGBTQIA+ community.

Tasia Jane Power

Humanitarianism in the Securitisation of 'Resettlement': The Cambodian Resettlement Agreement

Examines how Humanitarianism and Securitisation shape Australia's response to irregular maritime migrants. Globally, protection needs surpass humanitarian places. Using Critical Discourse Analysis, the thesis identifies Australia's use of humanitarian rhetoric and regional cooperation in the Asia-Pacific to advance a security agenda. Concluding the Cambodian Resettlement Agreement constituted a contemporary form of border control disguised as humanitarian action.

Nicole Joy Sim

"From Rubbles to Screens: A Comprehensive Comparison between Foreign Correspondents and Citizen Journalists Reporting in Conflict Countries"

The study investigates the individual experiences of foreign correspondents (FCs) and citizen journalists (CJs) reporting in Malaysia, Myanmar, the United States, and Australia. The initial findings denoted differences in the reporting styles of FCs and CJs, and the legal avenues and protections available to both groups. The preliminary findings from this study contest the confines of citizen journalism and explore concepts not yet rigidly defined.

Doctor of Philosophy

Yazan Mohammad Helal Al-Hayek

The implications of patient centring on CT number and radiation dose in CT imaging.

Yazan's thesis investigates the impacts of patient positioning on diagnostic accuracy and radiation dose to patients in CT imaging. Improper centring can cause significant changes in CT numbers and increased dose to patients. By surveying Australian radiographers, there are knowledge gaps in understanding the effects of scan parameters and patient size on CT imaging. It is recommended that practicing radiographers participate in CPD learning on CT imaging.

Annette Gwyneth Bowen

"Quality of Movement Outcome Measures for Equine Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation"

The Equine Quality of Movement Score (EQoMS) is a new tool for assessing horses' movement in physiotherapy and rehabilitation. Developed iteratively with expert input, the EQoMS has 30 standardised in-hand movement tests, a 5-point scale, and detailed directives. Testing showed high intra-rater reliability but moderate inter-rater reliability. The EQoMS tool allows a structured approach to track progress, monitor treatment effectiveness, and enhance horse welfare.

Anne Charlotte Johnson

Implementation of agroecological practices in viticulture: Identification of factors that motivate or constrain uptake

Agroecology is the science of increasing biodiversity on farms and using natural processes to make agriculture sustainable. The study found growers valued continuous improvement and leaving land in better condition. These values were driving change in vineyard practices. Market and financial uncertainties are constraints overcome by growers' passion for health of the environment and their vineyards.

Karly Melissa Liffen

Australian cattle feedlot working horses: a series of novel studies of welfare under field work conditions.

The welfare of Australian horses working in cattle feedlots was assessed via a survey, a case study using the Five Domains Model Framework and field-based behavioural and physiological responses. Whilst horses exhibited some conflict behaviours and were at risk of tack-based injuries when at work, their management when not working allowed them to perform natural behaviours and for their welfare needs to be met due to being kept in groups with access to forage.

Brianna Noel Maslen

Faecal Microbiomes and their Relationship with the overall Health and Productivity of Cattle.

This thesis describes significant variations in faecal microbial communities between Angus beef cattle exhibiting divergent weight gain and immune responses. Furthermore, the influence of host genetics on the composition of these communities has also been characterised. These findings could potentially inform the development of alternative strategies for enhancing animal growth and disease resilience, which can benefit the red meat industry.

Megan Jane Porter

*Parasitism in the black-spotted croaker (*Protonibea diacanthus*) (Teleostei: Sciaenidae) off northern Australia*

This thesis explored the parasites of the black-spotted croaker, an important fish in northern Australia. It revealed new parasite species, showed how parasites can trace fish movements, and how environmental changes affect parasite abundance. These findings help improve fisheries management and highlight the role of parasites in marine ecosystems and climate change responses.

Jonathan Paul Ramke

Exploring the Effectiveness of Ayres Sensory Integration Intervention for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder: A Mixed Methods Study in an Australian Context.

Dr Ramke has evaluated the effectiveness of Ayres Sensory Integration for children with autism spectrum disorder. In a mixed methods study, evidence of efficacy of ASI remained inconsistent due to methodological variability, divergent adherence to fidelity measures, and heterogeneous assessments. Evaluating these findings against NHMRC guidelines, the study advocates for rigorous application of ASI fidelity measures and development of validated assessment tools.

Paige Grace Tonkin

The Influence of Aerobic Exercise on Non-Motor Symptoms in the Mild-to-Moderate Stages of Parkinson's Disease

Paige's research explores how aerobic exercise impacts non-motor symptoms in early Parkinson's Disease. It reveals that engaging in regular aerobic exercise can lead to improvements in sleep, autonomic function, and overall cognitive performance. These findings stress the need for incorporating exercise into the treatment plans for people living with Parkinson's, as it improves their quality of life and symptom management.

Nan Wang

Export Competitiveness of Australian Wheat and Related Products: Analysis of Structure, Decisions and Policy Impact

This thesis investigates how Australian wheat production, its export structures, and trade policy environments such as Free Trade Agreements (FTAs) affect the export competitiveness of Australian wheat and related products. It finds that optimizing export structures significantly improves competitiveness, with FTAs amplifying this effect after about five years. Managing trade policy uncertainty can promote innovation in export structures and improve competitiveness.

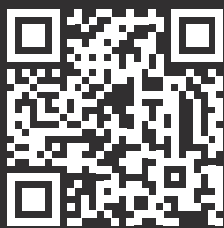
