



Mare Breeding Agreement 2026/2027

THIS AGREEMENT is made the day of

BETWEEN:

CHARLES STURT UNIVERSITY (ABN 83 878 708 551), through the VETERINARY CLINICAL CENTRE, a body corporate established by the Charles Sturt University Act 1989, located at the School of Agricultural, Environmental and Veterinary Sciences of Agriculture Avenue, Wagga Wagga, NSW (the Veterinary Clinical Centre); and

Background

- A. The Veterinary Clinical Centre of Charles Sturt University provides services associated with equine assisted reproduction.
- B. The client wishes to use the Veterinary Clinical Centre of Charles Sturt University for the purpose of assisted reproduction.
- C. The Veterinary Clinical Centre agrees to accept the nominated stallion for the purpose of assisted reproduction stallion services on terms of this Agreement.
- D. The client agrees to pay all fees and charges related to this event as set out under this Agreement.

AGREED TERMS

Representations by the client or their agent

1. The client or any person signing this agreement on behalf of the client represents that he is she is duly authorised to enter into and sign this Agreement as the client or for and on behalf of the client (as their agent) and that:
 - (a) the client is the sole owner of the mare, or
 - (b) the client is authorised by all others who may have an interest in the mare to enter this Agreement.

Required disclosures

2. The client agrees to disclose to the Veterinary Clinical Centre any underlying mare health conditions, including but not limited to, a history of laminitis, PPID or EMS. In addition, the client



agrees to notify the Veterinary Clinical Centre of any increase in rectal temperature, nasal discharge, diarrhoea, or illness prior to presentation at the Veterinary Clinical Centre.

3. The client is to disclose if the nominated mare is on a lease agreement and agrees to provide a copy of permissions relevant to breeding, and for the purpose of carrying a pregnancy or for the purpose of embryo retrieval.

Fees

4. The client agrees to pay the procedure fee as listed on page five (5) as set out in Item 1 of the schedule to this Agreement prior to admission for each breeding cycle
 - a) This fee includes all ultrasound examinations until a 45 day post ovulation scan, an ovulation induction agent, all necessary oxytocin and prostaglandin injections, artificial insemination and basic sperm analysis.
 - b) This fee does not include agistment, sedation or other drugs, non-routine procedures, caslicks suturing, lab fees or any additional costs in the event the mare becomes injured or ill.
 - c) Mares on breeding contracts with the Veterinary Clinical Centre are entitled to a 50% discount on post breeding management including:
 - i. Twin reduction
 - ii. Uterine lavage
 - d) A running total of additional charges will be invoiced at the conclusion of the package services.
5. The client agrees to make a separate arrangement with the stallion owner to pay for service fees, freight and associated cost involved in the delivery of sperm to the Veterinary Clinical Centre before the admission of the mare to the centre.
6. The client agrees to any further reproductive procedures deemed necessary (after consultation) by the vet and agrees to pay any additional charges involved with these procedures.
7. The client is responsible for all fees and other charges involved in the mare's care whilst in transit to and from the Veterinary Clinical Centre and while at the Veterinary Clinical Centre.
8. The client agrees to pay all charges prior to the discharge of the mare from the Veterinary Clinical Centre, or within the payment terms outlined at on the receipt of an invoice.

Failure to pay fees

9. If the client fails to pay an invoice by the payment due date the Veterinary Clinical Centre may charge the client interest (at an interest rate of 10%p.a.) on any outstanding amounts if those outstanding amounts remain unpaid for more than thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.



Disclaimer and limitation of liability

10. Charles Sturt University Veterinary Clinical Centre and its staff will take all due care and provide attention to the client's horse whilst at the Veterinary Clinical Centre.
11. Whilst in the care of the Veterinary Clinical Centre the client acknowledges there is a risk to the mare of illness, injury including the minor risk of rectal tear and colic which both may have life threatening complications.
12. The client/agent agrees to not hold the Veterinary Clinical Centre responsible for any injury or illness to the mare.
13. The Veterinary Clinical Centre is not responsible for the quality or fertility of frozen sperm supplied by the stallion.
14. The Veterinary Clinical Centre cannot make any live foal guarantees; a pregnancy certificate can be supplied after positive pregnancy diagnosis from day 42 post ovulation.
15. The client acknowledges that assisted reproduction is an elective procedure and will not hold the Veterinary Clinical Centre or its staff liable for any complications or death associated with the following:
 - a) Assisted reproduction.
 - b) Parturition.
 - c) Post-foaling complications.
16. Every effort will be made to contact the client prior to treatment for any unforeseen problem with the mare.
17. If the client cannot be contacted, the Veterinary Clinical Centre will treat the mare as necessary at the client's expense and the client agrees to pay any expenses incurred by the University Veterinary Clinical Centre under clause 16 of this Agreement.
18. Subject to clause 19, the Veterinary Clinical Centre's aggregate liability to the client under or in respect of this Agreement whether in contract, tort (including negligence), statute or any other cause of action is limited to the value of the total fees paid by the client for the frozen sperm to which the cause of action relates.
19. Nothing in this Agreement operates to limit or exclude liability that cannot by law be limited or excluded.



20. The Veterinary Clinical Centre shall not be liable to the client for any consequential loss, including loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss of any contract value, loss of anticipated profit or damages for lost opportunity.

Insurance

21. The client must effect and maintain the insurance policies set out in Item 3 of the schedule and any other insurance policy required by law in connection with the provision of the Services throughout the term of this Agreement.

Notices

22. Any notice under this agreement shall be in writing and may be given by post, email or by delivery to the party's address as set out in Item 3 schedule.

Governing law

23. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of NSW.

Entire agreement

24. This Agreement is the entire agreement between the parties in relation to its subject matter, and replaces all previous agreements, understandings and arrangements in relation to the same subject matter.

- I acknowledge that I have read the above and understood the nature and consequences of the procedures/treatments. I understand that the treatments/procedures may involve some risk and I give my consent for the treatments/procedures to be performed.

- I agree to pay all costs incurred in undertaking these treatments/procedures including those associated with livery and any additional cost whilst the animal is at the Veterinary Clinical Centre

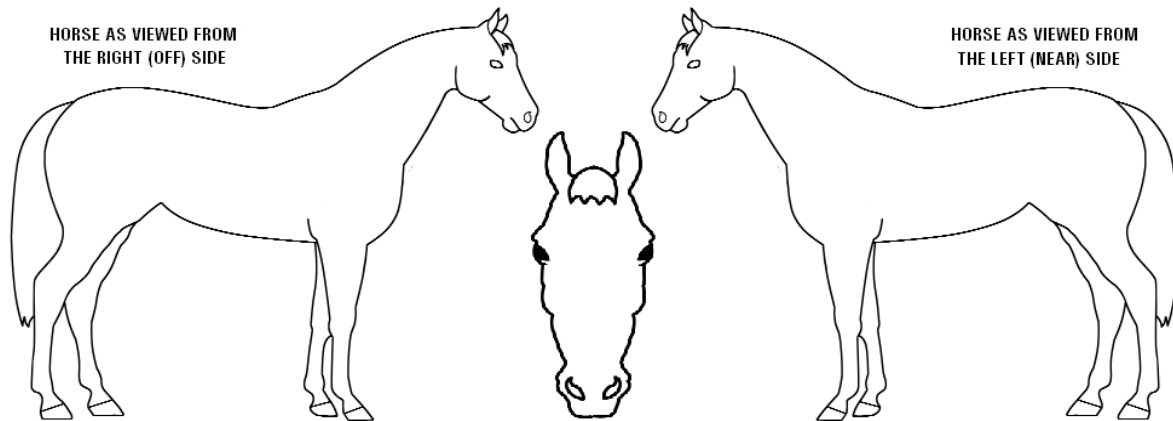
