### **GET INVOLVED**

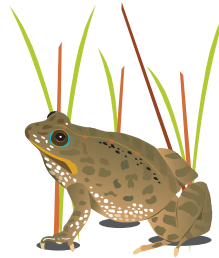
Be a part of CSU Green's sustainability community. There are numerous events, committees and engagement opportunities available including;
