

Dear colleagues,

As we countdown to Session 2/60, we want to ensure a smooth transition to Brightspace for everyone ahead of teaching and learning. Preparations for both staff and students are underway to ensure you have all the resources and support needed to get started in the new system. Whether you're already familiar with Brightspace or brand new, the following updates may be helpful.

Subject sites now available:

We have now successfully provisioned all subjects for Session 2 in Brightspace and they are available for the subject convenor/co-ordinator to edit in preparation for student early access on Monday 24 June and the commencement of learning and teaching from 8 July.

Updates to the Production Environment:

- Expanded permissions for user enrolments
 - Roles with the ability to enrol users can now also unenrol a user and change their role.
- The Learning Object Repository is live
 - The Learning Object Repository (LOR) is an easy way to share content between sites. Publishing content to the LOR allows it to be added to other sites by staff working on those sites.

• Training workshops continue to be offered to support you during the transition and can be booked <u>here</u>.

- New <u>Lunch & Learn Live Q&A</u> sessions will be held online with the LMS Project team, 12-1pm Monday, Wednesday and Friday leading into session start – drop in at any time to get your questions answered.
- Soon, we will also be adding more focussed Lunch & Learn sessions in key areas such as Marking Assessments, Rubrics, Grade Transfer and more.
