Charles Sturt Campus Services Limited (CSCS) has been chosen by NSW Training as award finalists in the category of Large Employer of the Year, the winner will be announced in Sydney on the 9th of September

CSCS has also been chosen as award finalists to receive the Chamber of Commerce Business award in the category for Business Excellence Murray – Riverina Region, the winner will be announced in Griffith on the 15th of August. About CSCS:

CSCS is a controlled entity of Charles Sturt University and operates under its own enterprise agreement, operating across CSU campuses in New South Wales. The company provides predominantly cleaning services though it also provides other services such as residential maintenance, a regional courier service, and a commercial laundry service.

The roots of the company expand over several decades, originally governed under more than four different entities these combined to become CSCS in 2009.

In terms of growth under the headings of safety, environment, quality, training, technology and operational efficiency; over the past two years the company has continued to improve.

Safety, Environment and Quality is of paramount importance to the CSCS team, each month a focus awareness package on the above headings is put together and delivered to the staff with the intent that it is an inclusive and educational session.

CSCS is committed to training; today the senior managers have their Diploma in Business, the middle managers have their certificate Four in Frontline Management and a few have progressed to complete further qualifications. Approximately fifty percent of the company's workforce has completed Certificate Three in Asset Maintenance "Cleaning Operations" and the other fifty percent are due to complete their studies in the next few months.

The company has embarked on a new journey of safety "accreditation" and along with purchasing sustainable consumables such as paper products and waste bags is also currently trialling a "green" sustainable chemical range which is looking very promising.
