

Interact2: Splitting up an individual assessment from the subject outline into multiple assessments

Overview

Likely scenario: An assessment item is the cumulative mark from a series of sub-tasks, such as 10 weekly quizzes.

1. Publish the Subject Outline, for example, with an assessment item for tutorial quizzes worth 10%. Use either **NA - submission not required/applicable** or specify **Interact2 test**.
2. If **NA submission not required/applicable**, delete the relevant Grade Centre column - go to step 4.
3. If **Interact2 test**, remove the assessment from Interact2 Subject Outline tool items. This will remove the item as well as the column in Grade Centre.
4. Create the new individual assessments with Interact2 tests tool (or other required tool). Ensure that the test is included in Grade Centre calculations, and that the total value of all individual assessments equals that in the Subject Outline for the whole assessment task.
5. Ensure that the new assessments are associated with the calculated grade/cumulative mark columns (ensuring the combined value is the same as that published in the Subject Outline).

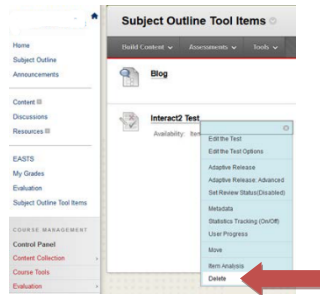

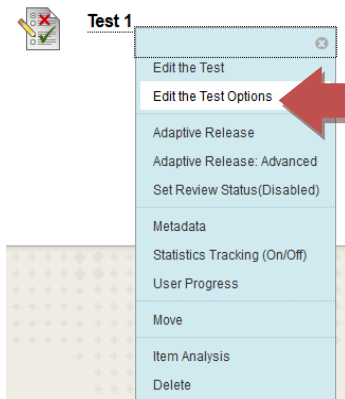

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3. If **Interact2 test**, remove the assessment from Interact2 Subject **Outline Tool Items**. This will remove the item as well as the column in Grade Centre.



4. Create the new individual assessments with Interact2 tests tool (or other required tool). Go to **Test Options** to ensure that the test is included in Grade Centre calculations, and that the total value of all individual assessments equals that in the Subject Outline for the whole assessment task.



SELF-ASSESSMENT OPTIONS

If this test is a self-assessment, choose to include or hide the scores in the Grade Centre. NOTE: If an instructor decides to include the test in the Grade Centre after it was hidden, all prior attempts will be deleted.

Include this Test in Grade Centre score calculations

Grade Centre items excluded from summary calculations are also excluded from weighting. Also note that if some weighted items are included in calculations and other weighted items are not, grade-weight calculations will be skewed.
