Our history

Our ethos, 'yindyamarra winhanganha', has been part of the Charles Sturt narrative since the very start. Our history dates back more than 125 years, to the establishment in 1895 of a vocational farm at Bathurst, designed to give rural people access to skills and education.

Over subsequent decades, agricultural and teaching centres were set up in Wagga Wagga and Bathurst, disseminating knowledge so individuals could improve their prospects and better serve their communities.

Charles Sturt officially became a university in 1989, merging the former Mitchell College of Advanced Education and the Riverina–Murray Institute of Higher Education, and incorporating educational facilities at Albury–Wodonga, Bathurst and Wagga Wagga.

Since then we have continued to grow, and now give students from across Australia and the world access to quality university education.

Today we have campuses in Albury–Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange, Port Macquarie and Wagga Wagga. We also have study locations in Canberra, Goulburn, Parramatta, Sydney and Wangaratta.

Our delivery of world-class online education is informed by more than 50 years of experience in distance learning. The majority of our degrees can now be studied online.

We have unique partnerships with a wide variety of organisations, including TAFE providers, the NSW Police Force, the Anglican Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn, the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries, Commercial Radio Australia, the Islamic Sciences & Research Academy of Australia, and universities in China and Sri Lanka.

We also have many partners around the world, enabling our students to undertake international study experiences, further expanding their horizons.

The man from whom the university takes its name – Charles Napier Sturt – was a British soldier who sailed to the colony of New South Wales in 1827 to pursue his passion for exploration.

The university mace

The Charles Sturt mace is the symbol of the university as an independent academy of scholars constituted under legal authority.

The mace is crafted from timbers indigenous to the locations of Charles Sturt campuses. It reflects the traditions and authority of the university, and symbolises its multiple geographies and responsibilities to the people of rural and regional Australia.



The university message stick

A gift from Dubbo Regional Council, this wooden message stick draws on elements of local indigenous culture to represent the entire Wiradjuri nation, whose borders encompass our campuses at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange and Wagga Wagga.




























Young and old emu feathers, which hang from the mulga wood message stick, denote students of all ages. A possum painting represents the local Wilay Wiradjuri people and red ochre lines depict the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers on which the university's Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga campuses are located.



Coat of Arms

This symbol bears the arms of the university at the centre. The graduation ceremony

The Academic Senate recommends students to be admitted to degrees. Those students (known as graduands) will have successfully completed a course of study and the prescribed examinations. The University Council formally admits the graduands, approving conferral of award as graduates.

The university medals

Undergraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a bachelor's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Postgraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a coursework master's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Bachelor Honours University Medal

Awarded to one Honours graduate per faculty, who has completed at least 64 points of study in the course at the university, and who has achieved Class 1 as an overall grade for the Honours course. At least one examiner must indicate that the student's thesis or dissertation is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Higher Degree by Research University Medal

Awarded to one doctoral and one master's by research graduate per faculty. At least two examiners must indicate that the graduate's thesis is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Charles Sturt Medal

Awarded to one graduate annually who has both an outstanding academic achievement (including a GPA of 6.75 or higher), and has demonstrated a significant contribution to the public good consistent with the university's motto 'for the public good'.

Bachelor of Nursing

Tammy O'Connor admits she is one of those rare and lucky people who knew early on how she wanted to make a real and lasting impact on this world.

"I studied a Bachelor of Nursing at Charles Sturt and I knew as soon as I started that I wanted to become a midwife. To me it seemed like such an awesome career.

"After graduating I worked as a registered nurse and quickly enrolled in the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery at Charles Sturt while working in the maternity unit as a student midwife. The uni gave me a great platform to learn in a safe environment, and provided a good stepping stone into my career. That's why I completed a Master of Midwifery through Charles Sturt. It opened the door to those higher level positions, including my current role as a clinical midwifery consultant for the Western NSW Local Health District.

"The beauty of nursing and midwifery is it can take you anywhere."

Tammy's 'anywhere' turned out to be parts of New South Wales which rarely received the health and educational support services they required. Realising women in remote areas needed access to antenatal and postnatal care, Tammy has been instrumental in implementing an outreach maternity program.

"I believe it's a basic human right for women to access a midwife during their pregnancy, regardless of their location. Working and living regionally provides me with the opportunity to work within the primary healthcare model of midwifery. It's what I love!"

Courtney Glazebrook is creating new beginnings by treasuring the past. Passionate about First Nations education, she is driven to make a difference in the lives of young Aboriginal children by giving them the best start to their educational journey. As the director of Towri Multifunctional Aboriginal Children's Service, each day that she opens the Towri doors, Courtney makes practical progress in her quest to cultivate a strong, connected and inclusive community.

"Towri encompasses health, education, community engagement and family support. Early childhood care has such great flow-on effects for families. While we're providing care for children we're also building platforms for parents, giving them the opportunity for employment and better health. We are building the capacity of whole communities. When children thrive so do communities.

"I have the opportunity to create tangible change. What we do, what we teach and what we advocate for directly impacts upon the community and everyone in it. I have learned, through my Charles Sturt studies and through my career, to question different regimes of truth.

"Aboriginal people are strong. We are connected. We are progressive. And at Towri we are creating new beginnings for those who come through. That really excites me."

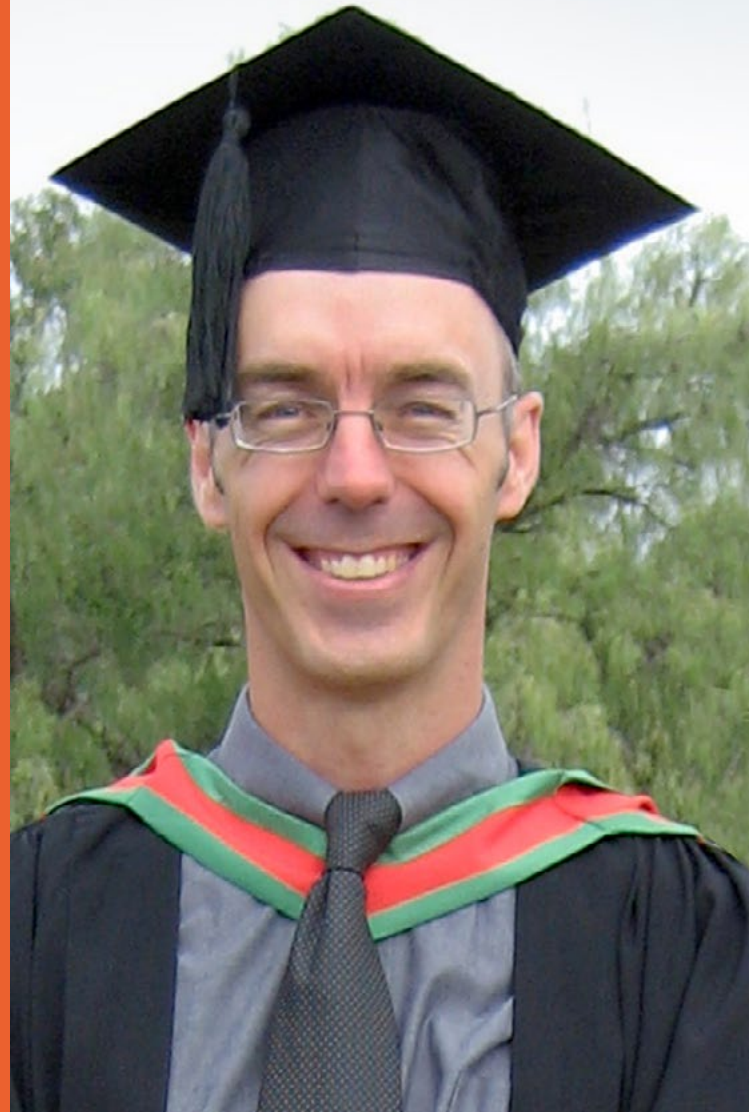

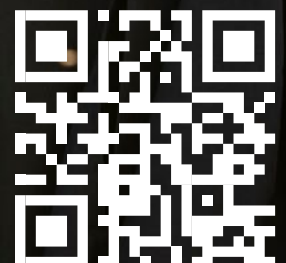

Celebrity politics in Australian local government: the case of Geelong's directly elected mayor model experiment.

This thesis examines celebrity politics through the rise and fall of the Directly Elected Mayor model experiment in Geelong. By examining two directly elected mayors whose prominence in Victoria's second-largest city marked them as celebrities in the early 21st century, the research assesses their electoral success and eventual failure of the model. This study provides insights into the impact and challenges faced by these celebrity mayors in their governance roles.

Stanley Lawrence Grant

Yindyamarra as theology: How a Wiradjuri Way of Being Leads us to a Deeper Peace and Justice in Jesus Christ

Yindyamarra is a Wiradjuri spiritual way of being that opens us to a universal love, peace and justice in Jesus Christ. I draw on my journalistic career covering conflict and enter dialogue with theologians poets and philosophers to explore the nature of evil, identity and violence and explore pathways to love and forgiveness grounded in Wiradjuri culture and being that leads us to a unique Australian theology.

Erin Hinton

OF OTHER PLANS: Re-viewing Canberra through the lens of other spaces

Conceived as a utopian city, Canberra is entangled in a struggle between its planned existence and the idealized image of that plan. The research explores the concept of heterotopia, other spaces that both represent and invert the planned view, as an alternative lens for understanding Canberra. It focuses on four principles of heterotopia to develop new perspectives to re-imagine Canberra and proposes heterotopic projects as a means to transcend its utopian legacy.

Dilini Bodhinayaka Ilaya Kuttige Don

Commencing undergraduate students' prior understanding of academic libraries in Sri Lanka: A grounded theory approach

This study explores how new undergraduate students in Sri Lanka perceive academic libraries before starting university. Using interviews, it found mixed views influenced by past experiences and external sources. Personal interactions, especially with friends who attended university, played a significant role. Understanding these perceptions is crucial for improving library services.

Marie Catherine Ireland

Evaluation and eligibility of students with communication disorders in public schools in the United States

This PhD by Prior Publication included 10 studies investigating evaluation and eligibility of students with communication disorders in U.S. public schools. The complex decision-making system was studied using the Cultural-Historical Activity Theory, patterns, identification of 9 tensions impacting team decision making, and potential solutions. This work informs policy and practice supporting improved outcomes for children.

Romany Manuell

The Education and Training Role of Australian Academic Librarians

Many librarians working in university libraries perform a role in the education and training of students, academics and others in areas related to research and information. This study explored Australian academic librarians' conceptions of their educative role. Findings revealed that librarians' conceptions are dynamic. Qualifications in teaching and training, and the kinds of duties undertaken within libraries, influenced librarians' conceptions in different ways.

Kate Elizabeth Margetson

Moving Beyond Monolingual Practices with Multilingual Children: Learning from Vietnamese-English-Speaking Children, Families, and Professionals

This thesis explored multilingual children's speech development through the analysis of Vietnamese and English speech from 66 children and 83 adults. The research focussed on speech assessment, transcription, analysis, and differential diagnosis of speech sound disorder. A new evidence-based clinical protocol, the Speech Assessment of Children's Home Language(s) (SACHL), was created to assess multilingual children's speech in their home languages.

Rebecca Lea Muir

'But what to the change?': An exploratory mixed methods study on developing public libraries as inclusive information and social services for people with hidden disabilities

Over 2.5 million Australians have a hidden disability (such as autism or mental health), yet there is little research on the social and informational inclusion of this cohort in public libraries. This study found that libraries are often ill-prepared for hidden disability, with staff insufficiently trained and hindered by a focus on enquiry volume. Recommendations are given for training, cultural, and data reviews in the sector.

Abiodun Oladipupo Odejayi

Distributive Justice, Equality and the Theopolitical Imperative: Oliver O'Donovan on the intersection of justice and equality: conceptual implications and practical applicability

Specifically, his concept of 'attributively just distributive judgement'— is used to probe contemporary discourses in justice, rights, and the practice of equality. A case-study in refugee resettlement also applies it to distributive fairness. The thesis finds that attributively just distributive judgements are crucial, if often under-recognised, in policy outcomes that aim for equality, dignity, and justice.

Naomi Jane Richards

Validating, Implementing and Generalising the Conscious Control Curriculum to Teach Emotional Self-Regulation Skills to Children with Challenging Behaviours

This study investigated the efficacy of a program entitled the Conscious Control Curriculum designed to teach emotional self-regulation skills and conscious control strategies to young children. The results indicate that all children improved over the sixteen weeks of the intervention in both clinical setting and the early childhood education centres the children attended. Parents, educators and children responded positively to the curriculum and their experiences participating in the study.

Tracy Anne Sorensen

The Vitals: Crochet and creative writing as posthuman praxis

My thesis represents the results of doctoral research into posthuman storytelling, specifically through a combination of an embodied handicraft (in this case crochet) with the more cerebral act of creative writing. My thesis is presented in two parts: the cancer memoir, and the humble practice of crochet in co-creating a posthuman story. These show how creative writing methods were used to take a posthumanist sensibility, honed through crochet, to a wider audience.

Analysis of Malicious Intruder Threats To Data Integrity

This research focuses on analysing malicious insider threats to data integrity, which can lead to severe consequences and organisational disruption. It investigates various threats and potential flaws that increase data integrity risks, emphasising the critical need for preventive measures. The study proposes novel solutions and demonstrates their effectiveness, achieving high accuracy (99.6%) against insider threats, thereby ensuring robust data integrity.

The Missing Perspective: The Coronial Investigation of Suspected Deaths and the Impact on Families of Missing People

Interviews of families of missing persons, police investigators and coroners provided insight into family experiences of suspected death investigations in coronial court and their unique disenfranchised grief following the ambiguous loss of a loved one. Two primary needs of families emerged: (1) timely Information, investigations and findings, and (2) meaningful inclusion in the coronial process. Practical measures to support families were recommended.

A Federated Learning Framework and System for Land Mapping with Deep Learning and Visualisation

This thesis introduces a novel federated learning framework and system for land use mapping. By integrating classical and deep learning algorithms, the system achieves enhanced accuracy and privacy. It has been implemented and validated by the five real-world datasets. Notably, the proposed framework and system enables local data analysis while safeguarding sensitive information from centralization, offering advantages for urban and environmental planning.

Investigating the occurrence and causes of ewe mortality during the peri-parturient period for commercial non-Merino flocks

This thesis investigates ewe deaths during lambing in non-Merino flocks across southern Australia. It identifies causes and risk factors for deaths, highlighting dystocia, septicaemia, trauma, and vaginal wall rupture as main contributors. Using Bayesian networks new risk factors have been identified while confirming known ones. To minimise ewe deaths, manage older ewes and those with multiple foetuses separately and ensure optimal body condition before lambing.

The Impact of Perjaya dam on fisheries biodiversity and livelihoods in the Komering river, Indonesia

The impact of Perjaya Dam impact on fisheries, ecology, and social ties holds major implications for Indonesian river management. The study highlights continuous ecological declines and engineering design flaws which are hindering river recovery and leading to ongoing biodiversity decline. Advocating for holistic approaches, the research suggests that integrating ecology and societal needs are needed for sustainable river health.

Amy Littleton Bates

The effect of breed and mating season on ewe management and potential enterprise profitability and risk across southern Australia

This research improved the understanding of sheep management practices and pregnancy scanning outcomes across breeds and mating seasons for a range of agroclimatic zones in south-eastern Australia using flock and producer surveys. A range of farming scenarios were subsequently modelled. Increasing supplementary feeding and reproductive rate were identified as possible means to improve overall enterprise productivity and profitability without increasing risk.

Emily Mavis Birckhead

Neutrophil extracellular traps and syndecan-1 in equine sepsis and inflammation

Sepsis is a dysregulated inflammatory response to infection that is difficult to diagnose and is a common cause of death in young foals. Emily's doctoral research focused on neutrophil extracellular traps (NETs), nucleosomes, and syndecan-1 as possible biomarkers of sepsis and infection. NETs were identified in septic fluid samples from horses, and plasma nucleosomes were increased in severe sepsis foals.

Structural analysis of protein-protein interactions involved in pathogenesis and viral replication of Lyssaviruses and Henipaviruses

This study examined the highly pathogenic rabies and Hendra viruses by analysing their protein structures and interactions with cellular trafficking proteins called importins. X-ray crystallography was used to solve the structure of two rabies virus proteins that are critical for viral replication and assembly. This information was used to develop a potential structure-based inhibitor against live rabies virus.

Seyedmohammad Ghafouri

Understanding the Structural Basis for Human and Viral Nuclear Localisation Signal Domains with Importins and RNA

Nucleoplasmic shuttling is one of the key features in eukaryotic cells, as the nuclear bilayer membrane encloses the genomic contents. This study investigated the molecular mechanisms involved in the nuclear import of human and viral proteins. The findings of this study revealed unconventional mechanisms of interaction between various cargoes and importin proteins. The outcomes of this research could be applied to the design of new potential drugs.

Beyond the binary: Youth access to mental health services in rural and regional New South Wales, Australia

This thesis examines the mental health experiences of rural youth in NSW through an arts-based qualitative study. It involved interviews and the creation of short films to explore how non-binary thinking and filmmaking reveal new insights into youth mental health in regional areas. The research assists stakeholders in enhancing mental health strategies, challenging metro-centric models and promoting a wider understanding of regional and rural mental health dynamics.

Bikshapathi Jagga

Structural and Mechanistic Basis for Nucleocytoplasmic Shuttling of Sox Transcription Factors

The thesis describes how SOX proteins enter the nucleus to direct important pathways including embryonic developmental. When mis-regulated, these pathways can result in cancer. The thesis describes new mechanisms for how SOX proteins enter the nucleus. Interactions were resolved to atomic resolution using the Australian synchrotron. The research provides a detailed understanding of how SOX proteins coordinate developmental biology, and new targets for therapies.

Liang Jiang

Rapid assessment for prediction and quantification of Botrytis cinerea off-flavours in grapes using mass spectrometry

Botrytis fungal infections of wine grapes result in the presence of off flavours and odours. This research developed methods for in-field sampling of Botrytis and established methods for the quantification of fungal infection by quantification of volatile compounds. An untargeted metabolomics workflow discriminated healthy from infected grapes demonstrating the feasibility for sensitive and specific detection of Botrytis fungal infections using mass spectrometry.

Thomas Keogh

Investigating the constraints on lamb growth in intensive feeding systems

Feeding lambs an unlimited supply of high-quality nutrients should enable them to grow rapidly, but this is often not observed. The growth of lambs was investigated with the assistance of CT scans. It was concluded that intake is the predominant constraint on lamb growth rates. Predictive lamb growth models were also assessed using CT scans of live lambs, demonstrating this technique to be useful for improving the precision of these models.

Thomas Peter Munro

Restoring native plant species to highly degraded sites with seed enhancement technologies

Thomas examined seed enhancement technologies to aid native plant establishment in three degraded contexts. This research demonstrates the potential of pellet seed enhancements as a tool to reintroducing native species. It acknowledges progress while stressing the need for further research and refinement to improve the applicability and success of pellet seed enhancement technologies for ecosystem restoration.

Soo Liang Ooi

Translational Research of Rice Bran Arabinoxylan Compound - From Nutraceutical to Cancer Therapy

This thesis is a comprehensive evidence synthesis of the translational research on rice bran arabinoxylan compound (RBAC). It critically reviews the health benefits of RBAC as a functional food and nutraceutical for immunity, ageing, and complementary cancer therapy. Through a clinical study, RBAC is shown to improve patients' quality of life during cancer treatment. The research outcomes contribute to the evidence-based applications of RBAC in health and medicine.

A Liyana Arachchilage Nisansala Nadeeshani Perera

Behavioural and electrophysiological responses of dung beetles to livestock dung volatilomes and constituent compounds

Dung beetles are important processor of livestock dung, releasing nutrients for plant growth and reducing fouling of pastures and dung-associated pests. This project explored the volatile compounds released by dung from different livestock species then assessed behavioural and physiological responses of dung beetles to these chemicals. This revealed the basis for dung beetle food preferences and paves the way for standardised baits for monitoring their populations.
