# Offline Accessible Resources (PebblePocket)

Please note: Converting a resource into a PebblePocket recourse is an external process that usually takes 7-10 days.

## When Should I Use PebblePocket With My Students?

PebblePocket is an offline app that has limited functionality but does allow students to create assets offline. This is **only recommended** for use when students are on Workplace Integrated Learning (WIL) placements **when internet is unlikely to be available**.

Please note: When possible, it is always recommended to access the full PebblePad program using a web browser.
