For appointments made via the Academic Institutional Leadership Position Appointment <u>form</u> in accordance with the <u>Appointments Procedure</u> for Academic Institutional Leadership Positions.

- Allowance amounts are based on a workload allocation of 100%. Allowances will be paid on a pro-rata basis for fractional appointments (including research workload). For example, a 0.7 AILP workload + 0.3 Research workload attracts an allowance of 70% of the relevant figure.
- Academic staff with a substantive appointment below Level C will receive an additional allowance up to Level C, Step 1, without annual incremental progression, for appointments which attract an allowance.
- Appointments will normally be for a period of three (3) years.

Superannuation payable:

- If the total duration of the appointment, including extensions, is less than or equal to three (3) years, <u>superannuation guarantee</u> is payable on the allowance.
- If the total duration of the appointment, including extensions, is greater than three (3) years, 17% superannuation is payable on the allowance.
