

Getting to and from CSU in Bathurst



The CSU Bathurst Campus is approximately 2.0 kilometres from the Bathurst central business district (CBD). The walking route from the CBD (William Street) to CSU takes you along William Street onto Panorama Avenue. Walking time from the CBD to CSU is approximately 28 minutes and is marked on the map in this TAG.



Bathurst BUSLINES operate the bus services in Bathurst. There is one route that services CSU Bathurst Campus. The route number is:

Route 526 University – TAFE & South Bathurst.

Route 526 services run in a loop from the CBD to CSU and return back to the CBD. The bus turns onto Village Drive off Panorama Avenue, and then follows Village Drive to Ordnance Road, to Research Station Drive and exits onto Browning Street.

CSU students can travel at concession fares upon the presentation to the driver of an appropriate photo ID from CSU. This service does not operate on Sunday or Public Holidays.

As the service ends in the CBD, you will need to coordinate with other bus services or modes of active transport to reach your destination. Further bus information, timetables and maps can be located at www.bathurstbuslines.com.au.

CSU Bathurst Campus is easily accessed by bicycle. The direct cycle route from Bathurst CBD to CSU is via William Street onto Panorama Avenue. The distance is approximately 2.1 kilometres with an average trip time of 10 minutes. However, the campus is easily accessed from all of Bathurst. The route is marked on the map in this TAG.

Bike parking is located at buildings **1220** (CD Blake gym), **1285** (CPD), **1411** (Mansfield), **1431** (Allen House), **1448** (Public Health), **1454** (Drama), **1460** (Dental Clinic), **1470** (CEW) and **Willet Sports Complex**. A bike shelter in **Carpark 8**, courtyard between buildings **1412** (Truskett Library) and **1413** (Student Amenities Centre). Public shower and change facilities are available in buildings **1220** (CD Blake gym), **1412** (Truskett Library), **1435** (Cunningham Building).
