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# 1. Introduction

- 1.1 This grant aims to support the development of early and mid-career researchers to build their research capability, including the ability to publish in high quality journals and secure external grant funding.
- 1.2 Alternate activities that develop the research profile of early and mid-career researchers may also be supported.

# 2. Funding

- 2.1 Requests of up to **\$3000** will be considered
- 2.2 Funding must be spent by 1 December 2023

# 3. Eligibility

Research Development Grants are open to:

- 3.1 Academics in a teaching/research or research work function employed in the Faculty of Science and Health
- 3.2 Early and mid-career researchers who hold a research higher degree
- 3.3 Academics that demonstrate alignment with Faculty research priorities. Please contact your AHoS RGS to discuss.
- 3.4 Academics who have not already received a Research Development support in the same calendar year
- 3.5 Academics who have submitted all final reports for previous awards

# 4. Budget Items

- 4.1 Grant funding **may** be used for:
  - Attending external research workshops/training and associated costs;
  - Specialist advisory services including statistical support;
  - Research infrastructure (eg. software);
  - Supporting research collaboration;
  - Other activities that will build research capability.
- 4.2 Grant funding **may not** be used for:
  - Teaching buy-out
  - Conference attendance
  - Pilot projects or data collection or analysis

## 5. Assessment Criteria

Applications will be assessed using the following criteria:

- 5.1 quality of the proposal;
- 5.2 value for money with a realistic budget;
- 5.3 alignment of activity with applicant's research plan;
- 5.4 alignment of activity to Faculty priority research areas
- 5.5 Likelihood of the activity leading to quality outcomes such as Q1 publications, collaborations, grant submissions

## 6. How to Apply

Applicants must complete this application form and submit the application as a single PDF attachment (including HOS endorsement in writing, budgets and any supporting documentation) to [Tri-Faculty-Research@csu.edu.au](mailto:Tri-Faculty-Research@csu.edu.au)

Application and supporting documentation must be submitted as a single PDF file and should be named according to the following convention: "Surname\_Research Development" e.g. "White\_Research developmentS".

Applicants must obtain Head of School endorsement prior to submission.

## 7. Reporting

7.1 A one-page report detailing outcomes of the research development activity is required one month after completion of the activity.
