Administering The Rural Australia Foundation Orange Fund

The Rural Australian Foundation (RAF) was established to support the advancement, development and practical application of science and technology to agricultural industry and commerce by the development and support of any educational, research or related activity at the Orange Campus as well as rural and related service industries.

Such activities may include:

1. To develop, promote and support the invention, evaluation, modification or enhancement of equipment, methods and systems to the improvement of production and other products;
2. To develop, promote, or support educational activities of every description by conducting and supporting conference, seminars, workshops, discussion groups, home study courses, displays and exhibitions generally and the rural community in particular;
3. To facilitate the preparation, editing, printing, publishing, filming, television of works;
4. To organise and to pay for in whole or in part visits by prominent authorities from academic institutions, commerce or industry to engage in activities;

Funding will commence 14 July 2023 and go through to 1 December 2024.

Funding requests of up to \$15,000 will be considered.

Applications for the 2023-2024 period will **close 2 July 2023**.

All monies must be spent before the 1 December 2024 deadline. There is no facility to carry funds over to the following year.
