

Banana Superfood Muffins

Ingredients

cup wholemeal flour
cup rolled oats
teaspoon baking powder
teaspoon salt
teaspoon salt
cup chia seeds
cup L.S.A. meal
cup coconut sugar
egg
ripe bananas, mashed
teaspoon vanilla extract
tablespoon olive oil
tablespoons apple sauce
cup quinoa, cooked

Method

Preheat oven to 190C and line a 12 cup cupcake tin with patty pans.

Combine flour, oats, baking powder, salt, chia seeds and L.S.A. meal in a bowl.

In separate bowl, beat coconut sugar and eggs until light and foamy.

Add vanilla extract, banana, olive oil and apple sauce to egg mixture and stir well, then fold in cooked quinoa. Add dry ingredients to wet mixture in 2 or 3 batches and combine well.

Divide mixture evenly among the 12 patty pans. Bake for 23-25 minutes.

Remove from oven and allow to sit in tin for 10 minutes before transferring each muffin to a cooling rack. When completely cool, store in an airtight container.

CHARLES STURT DENTAL CLINICS

Regular oral health check-ups and preventive dental cleaning is a very important part of maintaining your general health. Charles Sturt Dental Clinics include learning facilities that support students training to be Oral Health Therapists through the Bachelor of Oral Health program.

Appointments are available to see Oral Health Therapy students at the Dental and Oral Health Student Clinics in Albury and Wagga. CSCS staff are eligible to receive free check-ups and cleans with our Oral Health Therapy students. Subsequent treatment may incur additional fees, if required.

Oral health therapists are experts in preventing dental decay and gum disease. Under the direct supervision of registered dental practitioners, oral health therapy students provide comprehensive check-ups and cleans for patients of any age. Children and young people (up to 26 years) can be seen for additional procedures such as simple fillings and extractions of baby teeth. Students will refer any complex dental treatment to other dental team members such as dentists and specialists for ongoing dental care.

If you don't have a regular dentist or oral health therapist, please consider visiting the student dental clinics in Albury or Wagga.
