Dr Andrew Peters completed a PhD at CSU on parasite evolutionary ecology in 2013 after practicing as a veterinary clinician for five years with a BVSc (Hons I) from the University of Sydney (2004) and Membership of the Australian and New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists in Avian Health (2008). Andrew is an experienced clinician, effective teacher with outstanding student feedback, and a productive early career researcher. He is a leader in the interdisciplinary field of wildlife population health, serving on the board of Australia's peak body (Wildlife Health Australia) since 2015 and serving as elected chair of Australasia's preeminent scientific body representing wildlife health sciences, the Wildlife Disease Association Australasia, from 2015-19. He is the chair of the Futures Committee, and 2019 nominee for Vice President, of the international Wildlife Disease Association, which has approximately 1600 professional and academic members.
