On acceptance to the course, candidates who do not hold registration as a psychologist must apply to the Psychology Board of Australia for provisional registration. Provisional registration is usually granted for one calendar year and must be maintained. https://www.psychologyboard.gov.au/Registration/Provisional.aspx

Online application to the Psychology Board of Australia for provisional registration is available if you:

- have completed an accredited fourth-year psychology degree in the last ten (10) years (or will be finishing soon), and
- have never previously been registered as a health practitioner or student with one of the 14 health professions boards in Australia, and
- have been offered a place in an accredited fifth-year psychology program

All candidates must hold full or provisional registration. Candidates whose application for provisional registration has been refused by the Psychology Board of Australia will be removed from the program. Candidates who hold full or provisional registration which is subsequently cancelled by the Psychology Board of Australia will also be removed from the program.

Compulsory Attendance Requirements

Some subjects have a requirement to attend <u>compulsory</u> online intensives in full. Students who are not able to attend these intensive schools will not be able to complete these subjects, and thus will not be able to undertake the program.

ASSESSING ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

The **Master of Clinical Psychology** requires the satisfactory completion of a four-year APAC-accredited qualification in psychology (or equivalent qualification) to have been completed within the previous ten (10) years with a **Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 75%** or higher for the 4th-year of study.
